Dear Downtown Property Owner:

We are glad to have downtown included in the Town of Corydon's historic preservation efforts! Your property has recently been included in a locally designated Corydon Historic District. Downtown is very worthy of this protection – it is the heart of Corydon and has great architectural, cultural and aesthetic importance to the town.

Town of Corydon Ordinance No. 2016-13 established the Town of Corydon Historic Preservation Commission. Main Street Corydon also adopted a set of architectural guidelines on April 21, 2015, which the Historic Preservation Commission will review and adopt as well. This is to ensure that any changes to structures within our historic district are compatible with our community's historic character. "Community" is the key word – we all benefit if our historic district is attractive and the buildings are in harmony with one another. The enclosed map shows the boundaries of the district.

Before undertaking any exterior work other than routine maintenance, downtown property owners or tenants within the historic district are required to obtain a Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) from the Historic Preservation Commission. The application for the COA is on the Town of Corydon website, www.TownofCorydon.com (under Town History), or we can email one to you. We also have paper copies at the Town Hall. If you would like to discuss plans regarding your building, please call Corydon Town Hall and speak with Carolyn Hofelich, Planning & Zoning or Eva North, President Corydon Town Council, 812-738-3958. A member of the Town of Corydon Historic Preservation Commission can discuss your plans.

Regular meetings of the Town of Corydon Historic Preservation Commission are open to the public. The meetings are held at 6:00 p.m. on the 1st Tuesday of each month at the Corydon Town Hall.

If you have any questions or need further information, please feel free to contact us or attend one of our meetings. We look forward to working with you toward the further revitalization of historic Corydon.

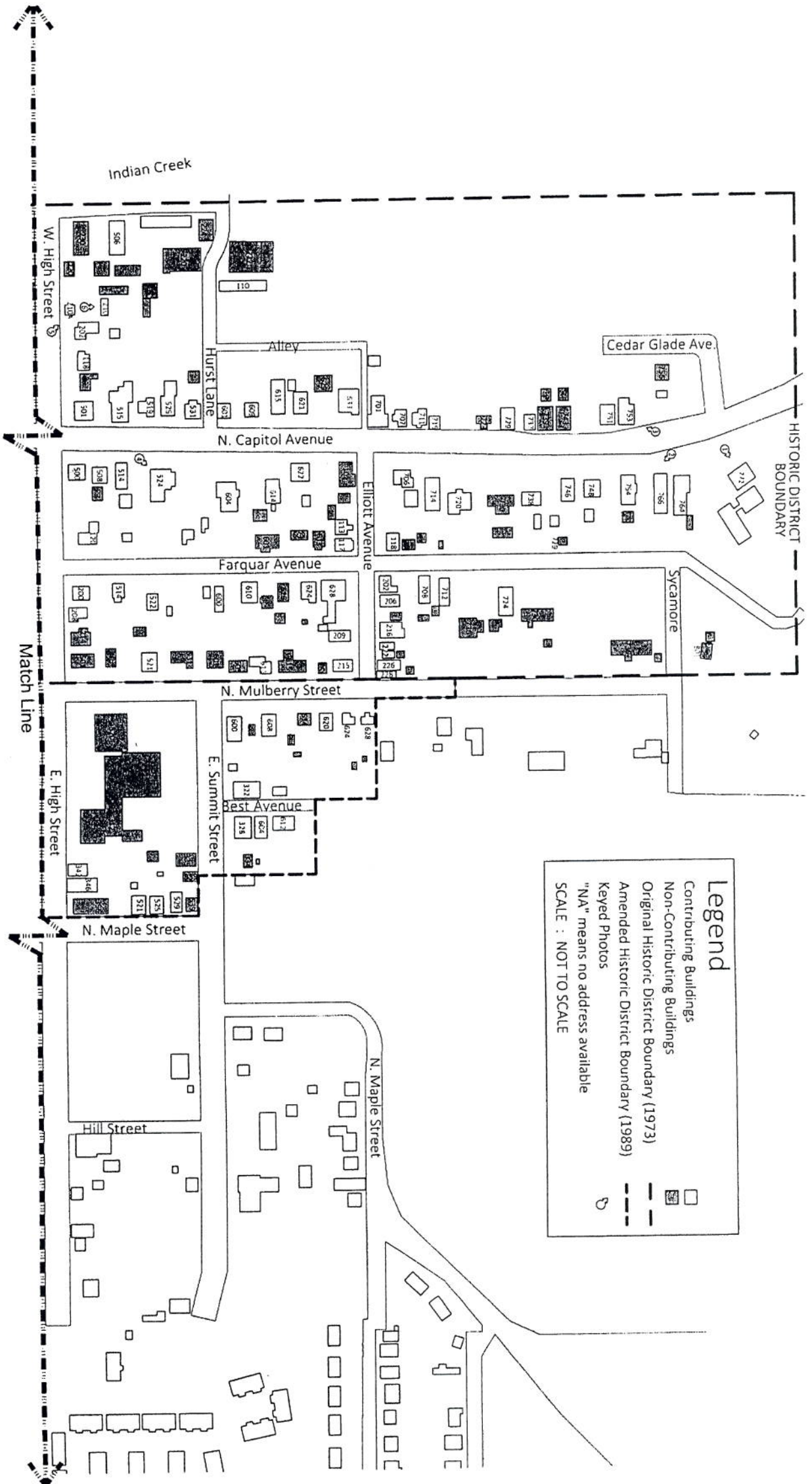

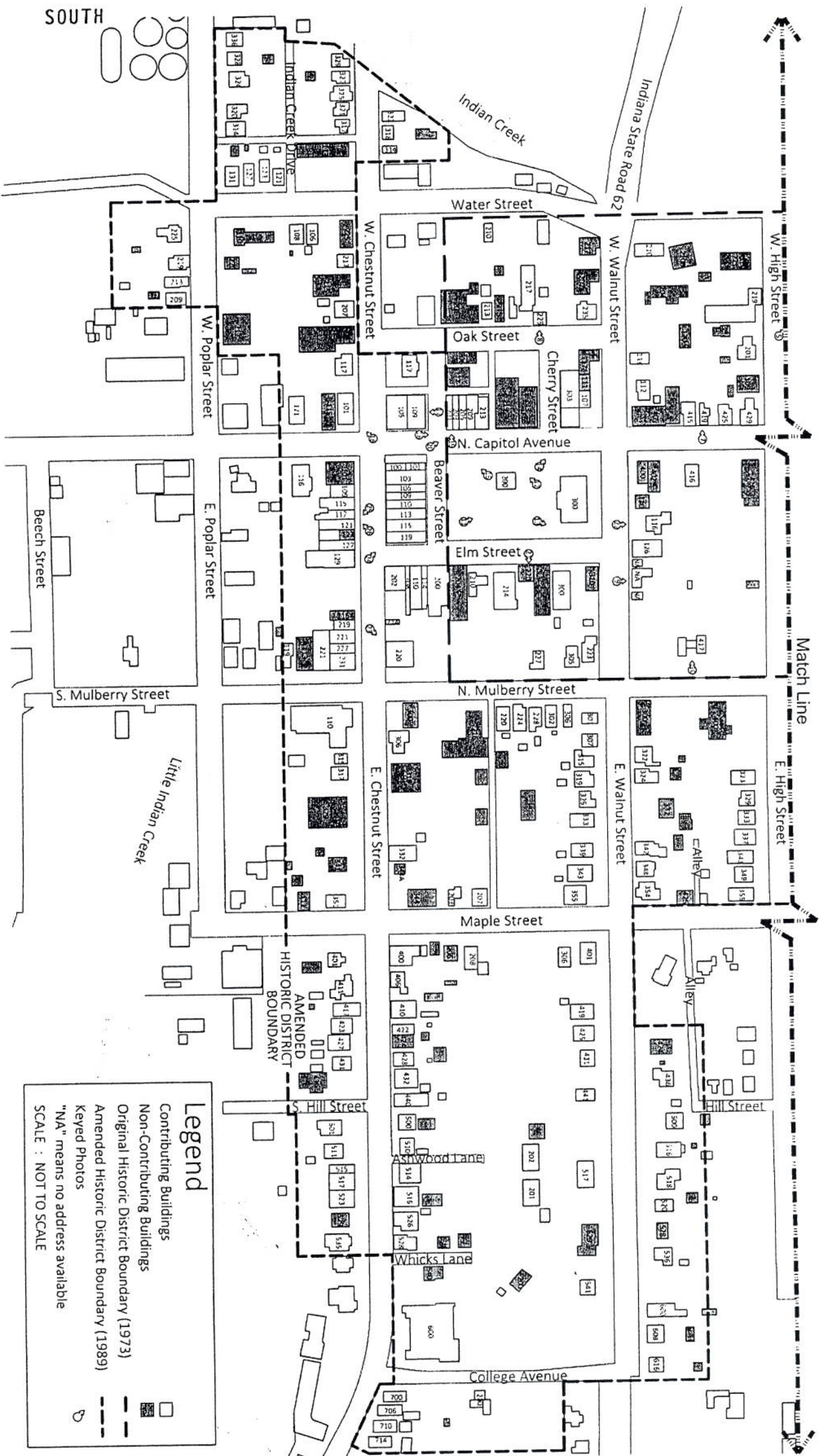
