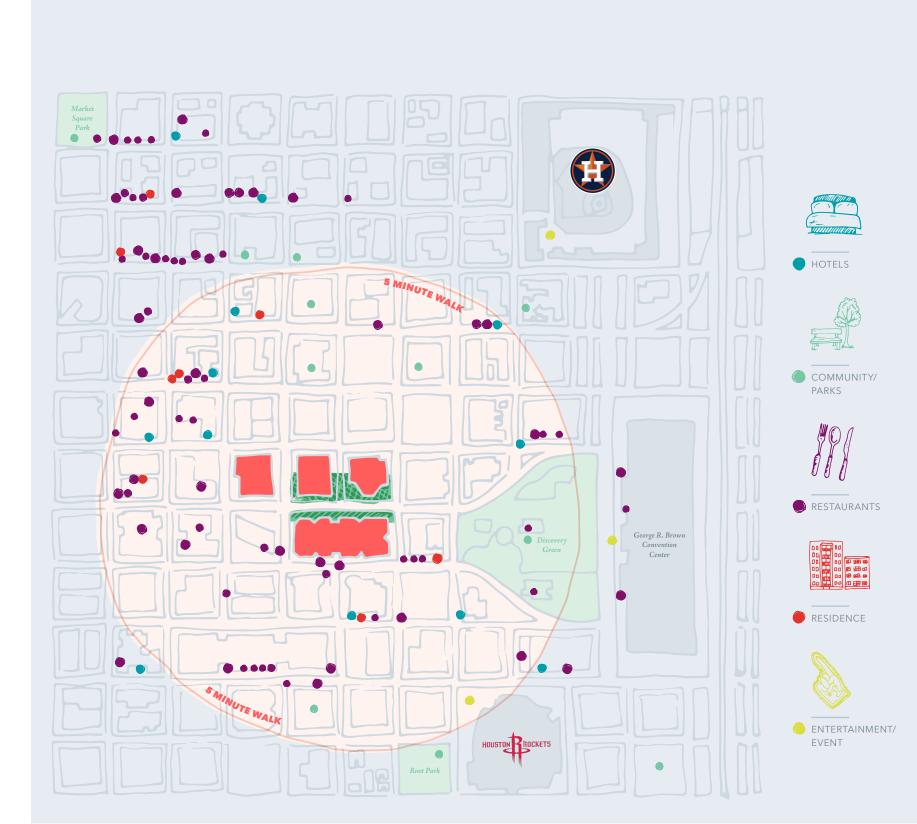

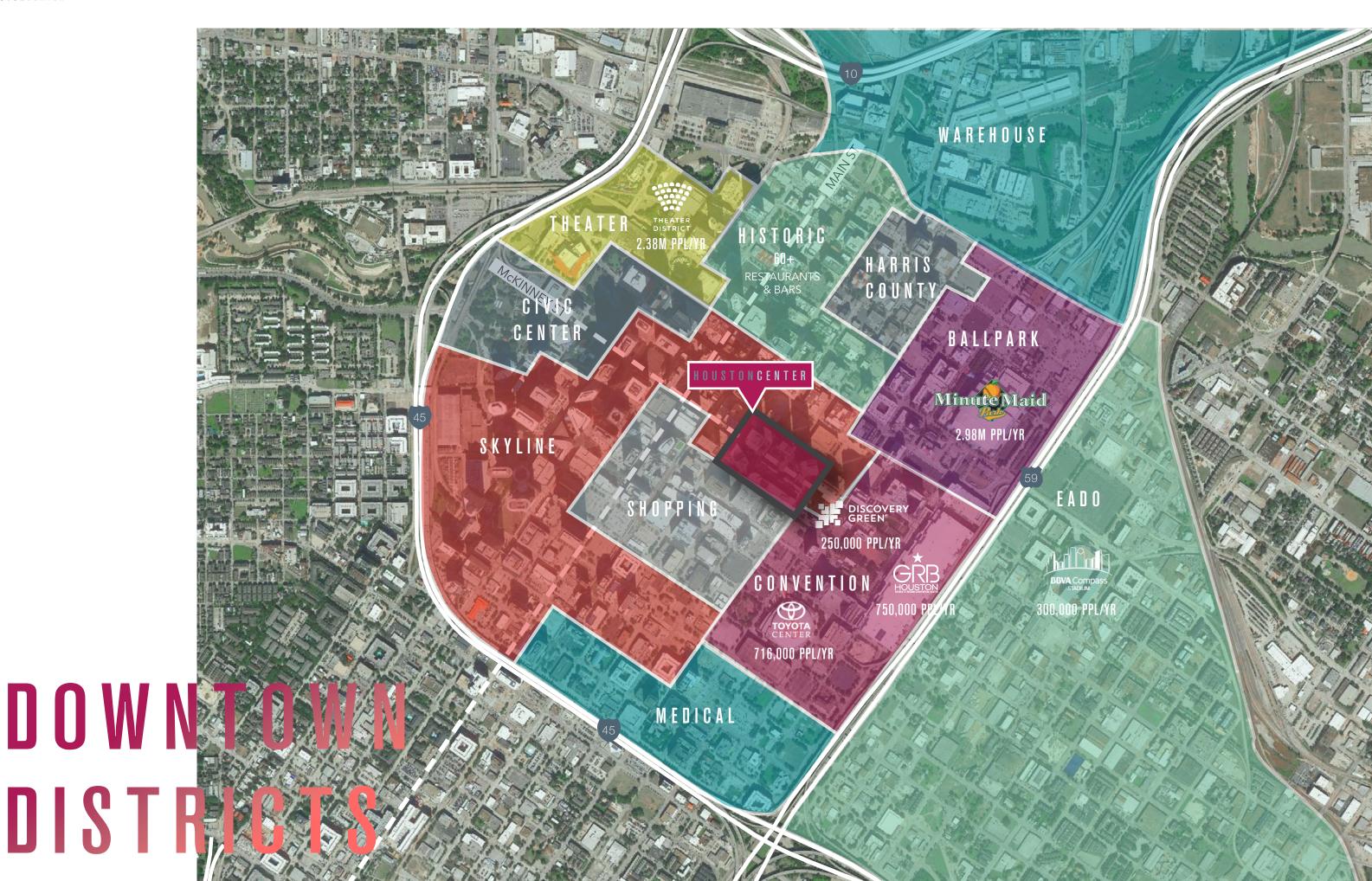

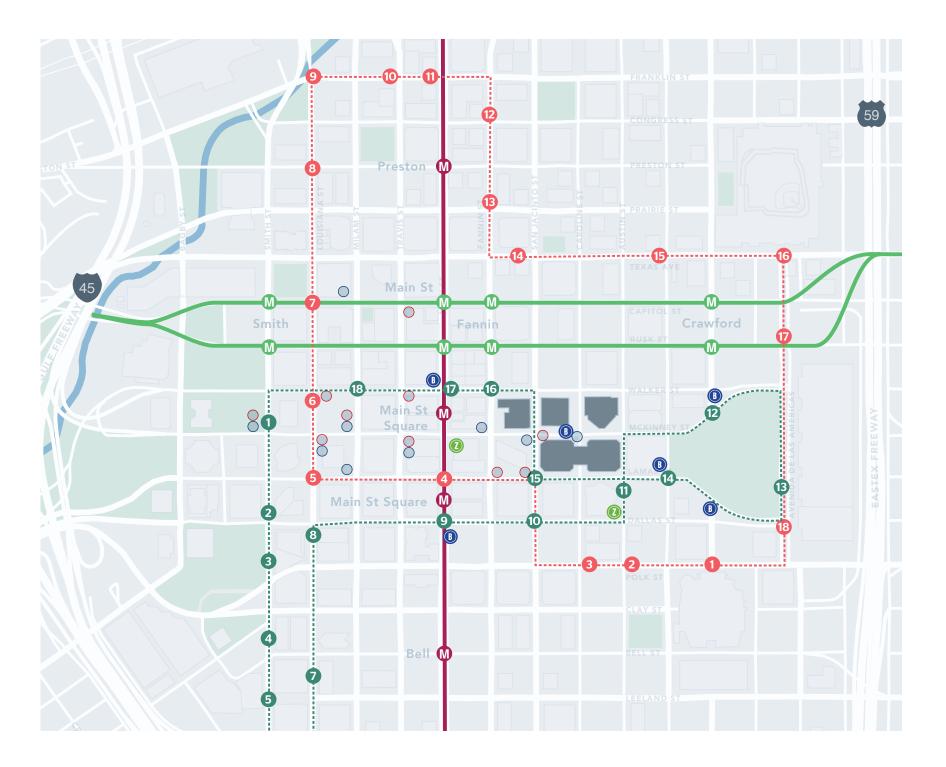
ATTH HEART THE CITY.

Occupying five blocks along McKinney Street, the new Houston Center engages visitors and users by activating both sides of the streetscape.

At the heart of the project is a new central plaza, creating a sense of place.

Intuitively and visually connecting the building podium levels to the street, the vibrant central plaza features a digital water wall, flexible entertainment space, and an iconic monumental staircase to the landscaped terrace and sky deck above.

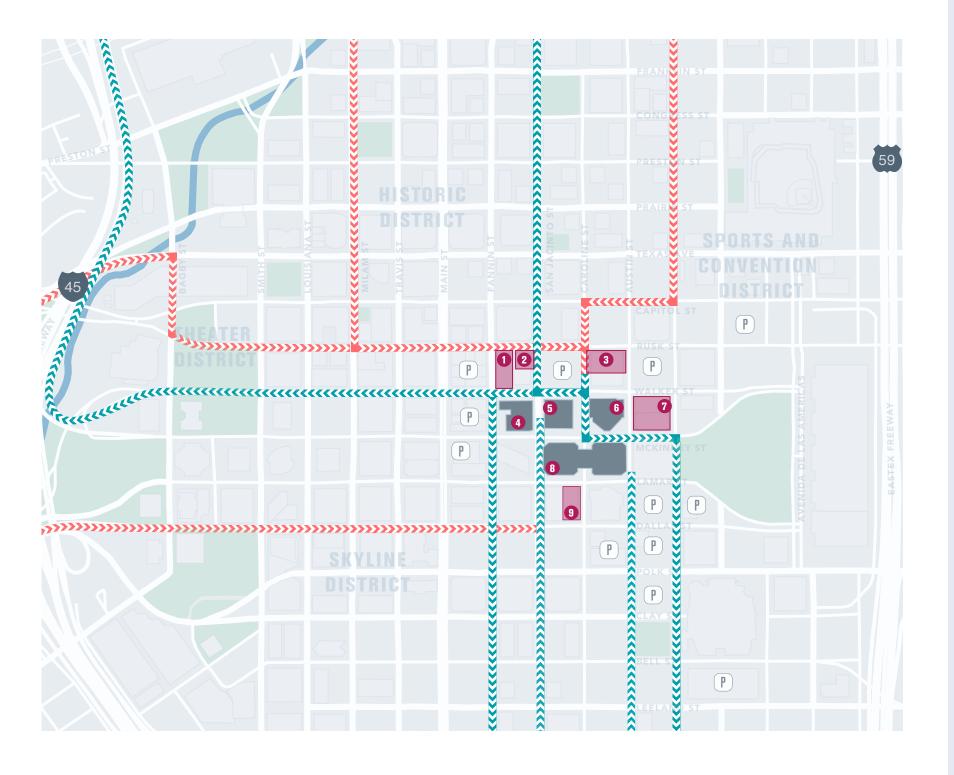

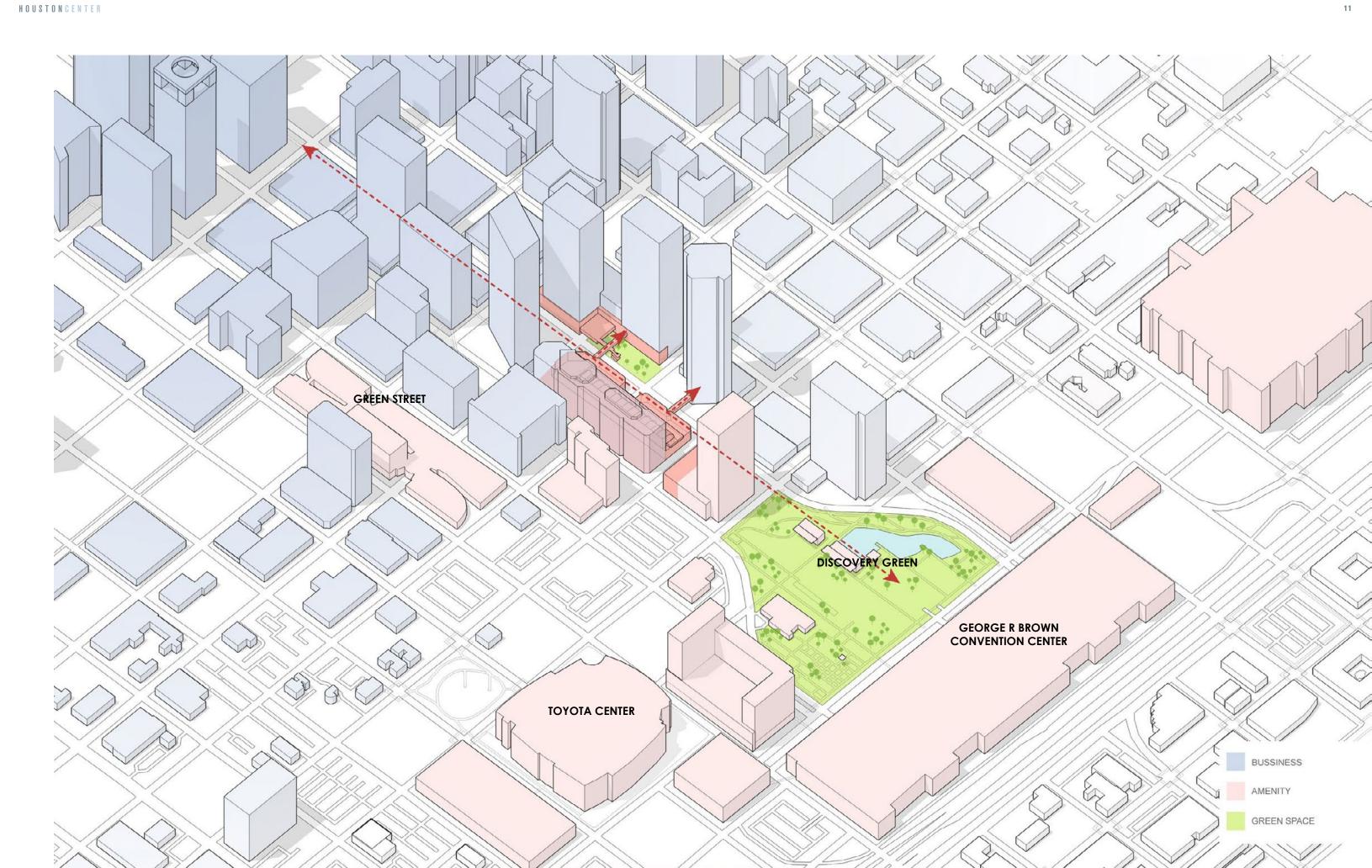

THE TRANSFORMATIVE VISION FOR HOUSTON CENTER INCLUDES:

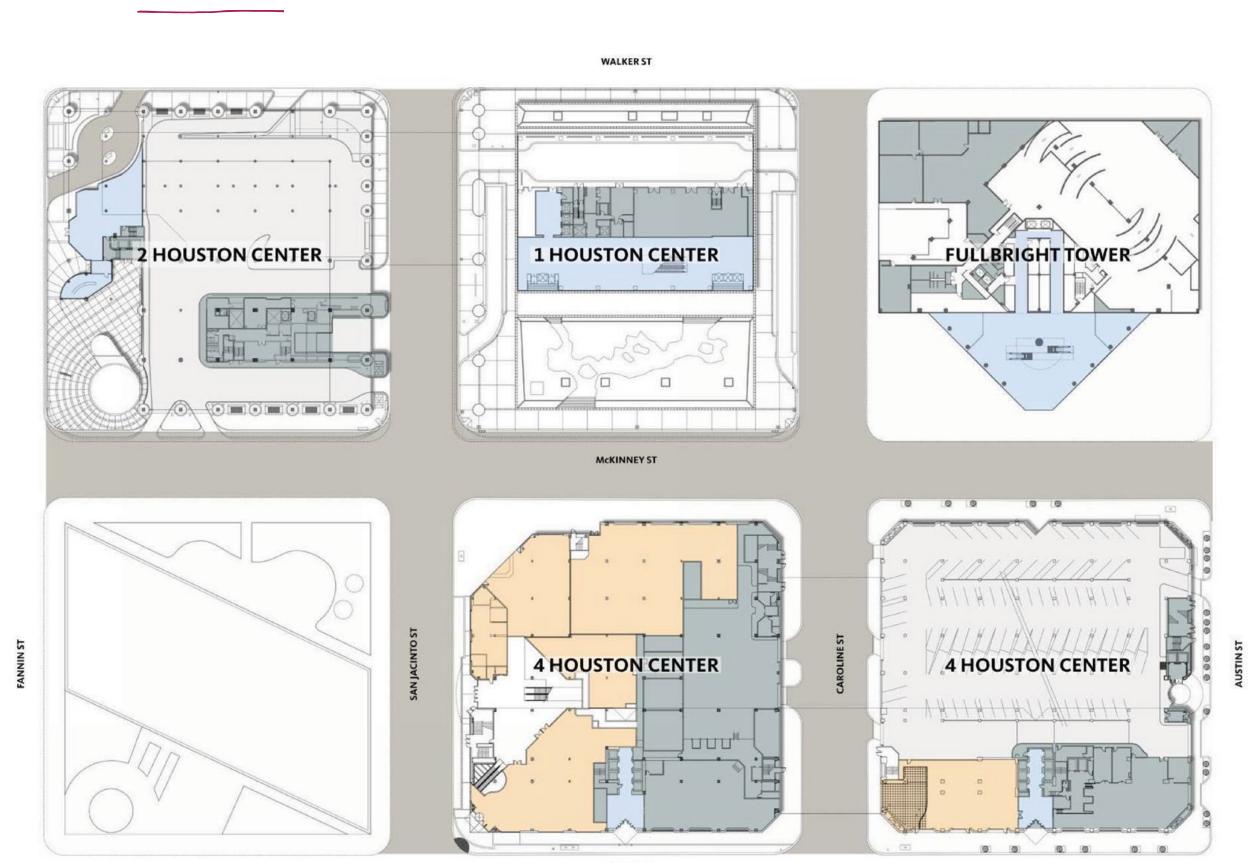
- + An entirely new arrival experience through a reimagined central plaza and greenspace, offering a seamless connection to the street and nearby attractions.

EXISTING SITE PLAN - GROUND LEVEL

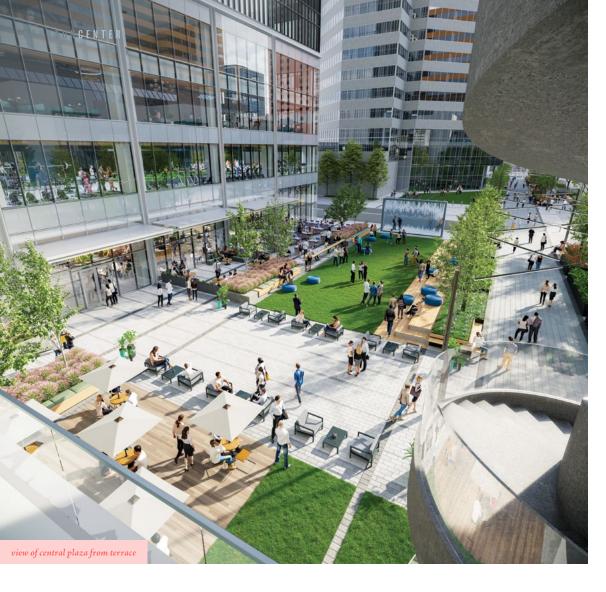

PROPOSED SITE PLAN - GROUND LEVEL



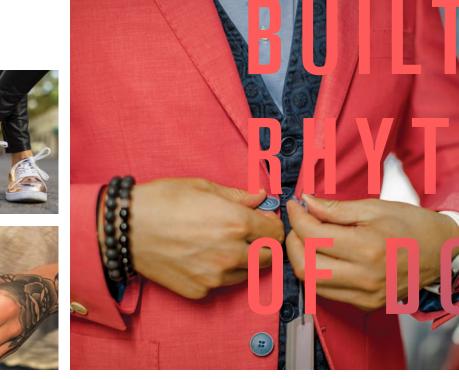


Set in a dynamic environment along Houston's Innovation Corridor, Houston Center prioritizes connectedness and hospitality.

Accessed via a spiral staircase, the sky deck and terrace offer elevated views overlooking the central plaza and new retail.











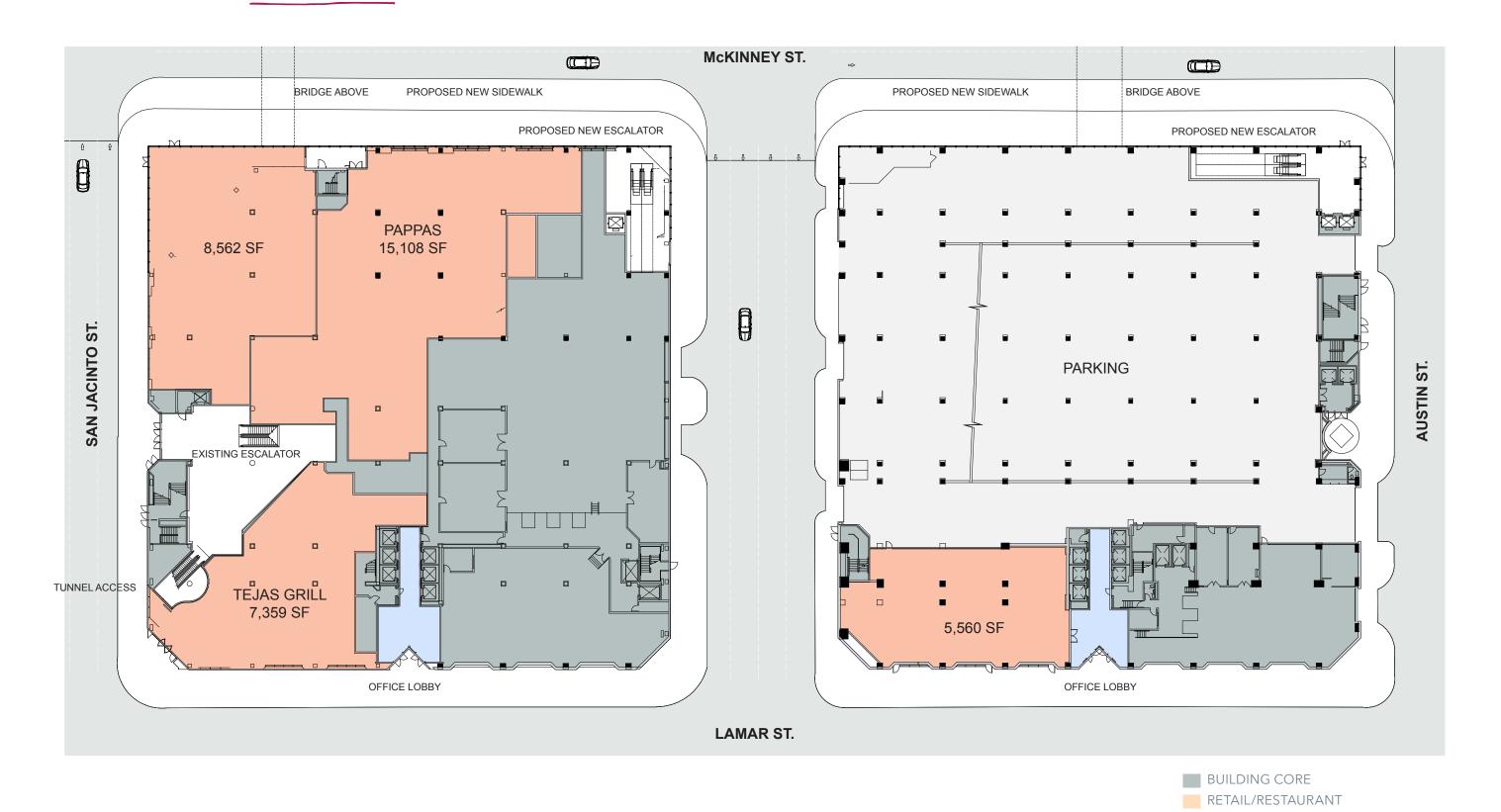

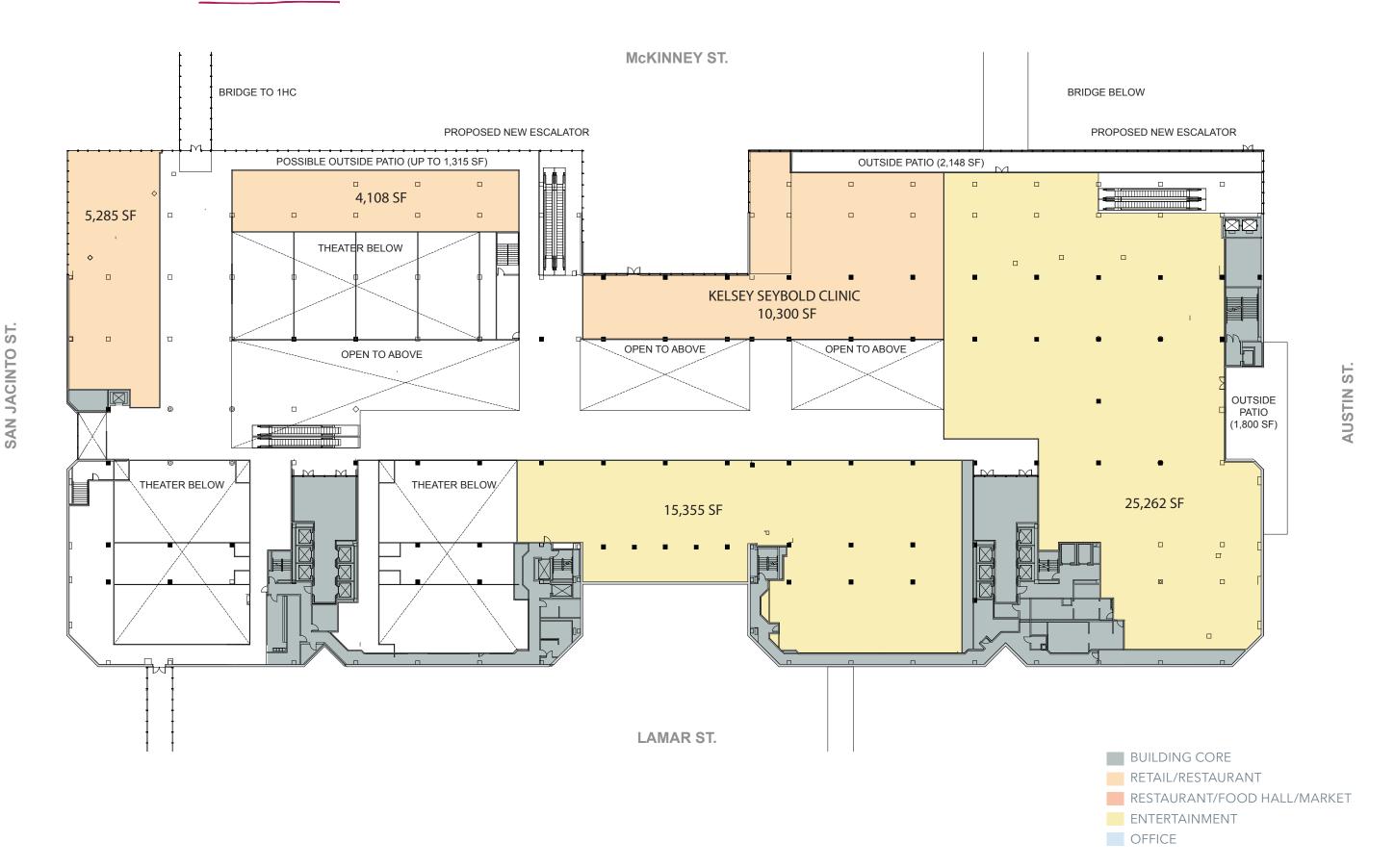

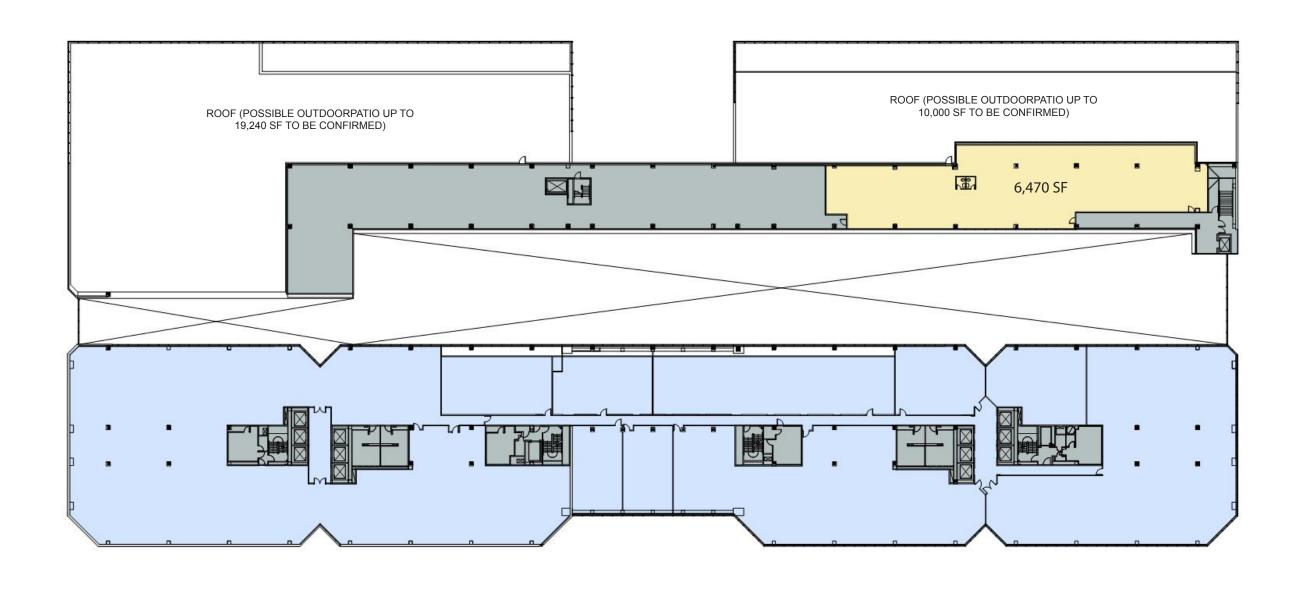

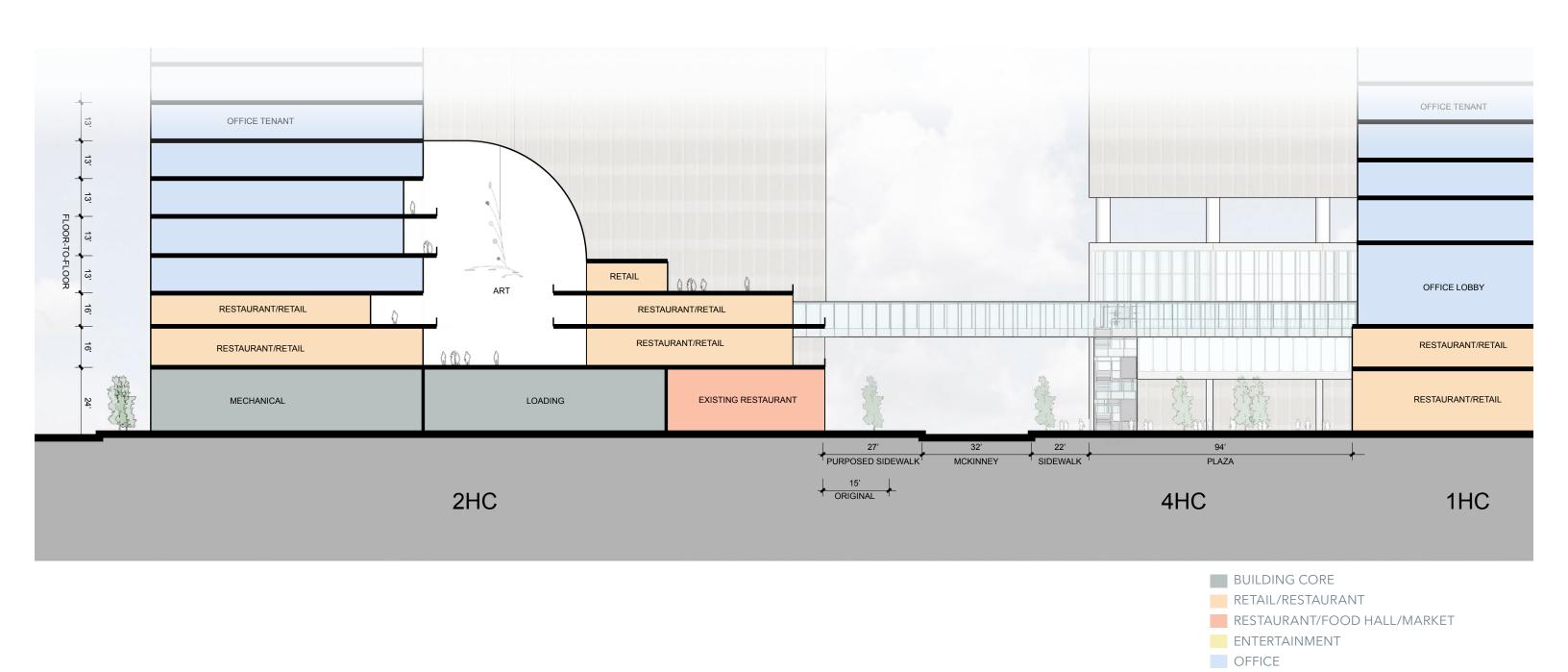

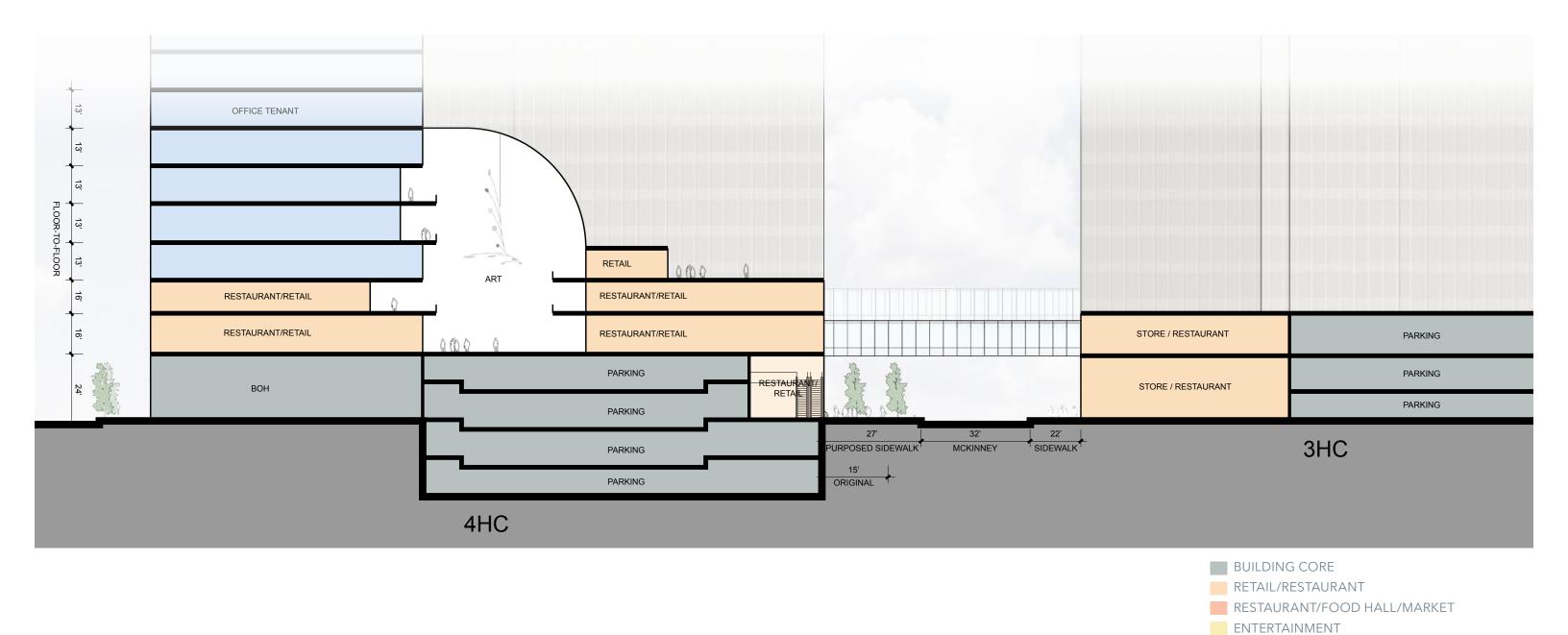

PROPOSED SITE PLAN - WEST SECTION

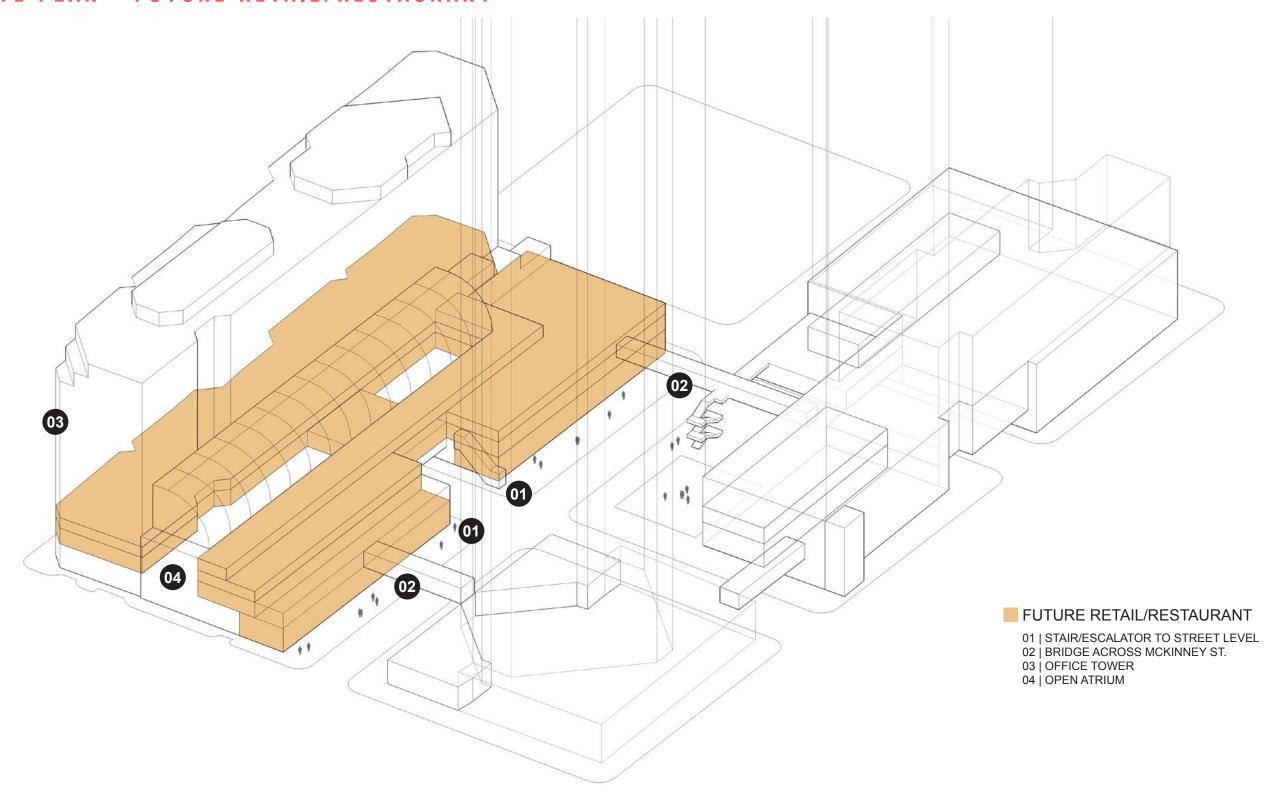

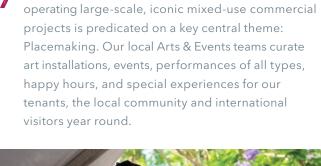
