

**Troop 35 Six-Point MOM's Contract for 2009-2010
(September 1, 2010 - August 31, 2011)**

In compliance with Troop Archives, the responsible parent who lives in the Baltimore area will honor the Troop 35 Contract. The Mom's Contract is to be used only by the Mother who is responsible for her son's participation. *There will be only one Contract parent per Family.*

I AGREE TO:

1. Attend each of the Troop Committee's Quarterly Meetings. (The first TCQ is scheduled for September 3, 2010 at 6:30 p.m. Subsequent TCQ's are scheduled in the Troop Calendar/Roster.) If unable to do so, I will arrange for an alternate to attend the TCQ and I will attend the next regular Troop Committee Meeting, held the first Wednesday of the month, except July and August, at the Church. If I must be absent for a TCQ, I will call the Contract Chairman prior to the TCQ.

2. Do Two (2) of the following: (Check two from 2.1 through 2.6)

2.1 Organize and aid Scouts with a fund-raising event as designated by the Troop Committee.

2.2 Organize and conduct a 2010-2011 Friday Night Program and formal follow-up at the next Hi-Level. (Must be arranged in advance through the Friday Night Chairperson; see 2010-2011 Troop Calendar/Roster for the names of Troop Committee Chairpersons.)

2.3 Drive both ways on either a Spring or Fall Overnighter (OV). I have indicated the number of Scouts other than family members that I can transport. I am expected to make a serious effort to recruit and drive at least one other Scout to the OV in addition to family members by calling Scouts and the Transportation Coordinator. If unable to drive due to an unavoidable 'personal conflict, I will: (1) find an alternate driver, and (2) call the Contract Chairman and Transportation Coordinator prior to my originally scheduled OV to schedule myself for a make-up and to report the name of my alternate.

3. Volunteer to provide one "DOUBLE TREAT" for a Friday night program.

4. Assist with preparations for the TROOP's ANNUAL BANQUET. (See Troop Calendar/Roster for date.)

5. Assist with the 2011 40-MILER HIKE.

6. Act as a Psi Patrol contract person if requested to do so. (The Psi Patrol is made up of all parents of Scouts in Troop 35. The purpose of the Psi Patrol is to give the parents of each new Scout a contact person who can acquaint the new parent with the customs and functions of Troop 35 and answer questions about the Troop. Having such a contact person should encourage the new Scout to stay in the Troop. As each new Scout joins the Troop, his parents will be assigned to a member of the Psi Patrol. Any parent who is requested to act as a Psi Patrol contact person during the year is expected to do so.)

I UNDERSTAND THAT THE SUCCESS OF TROOP 35's PROGRAM AND THE CONTINUED PARTICIPATION OF MY SON(S) IN THE TROOP DEPENDS UPON MY COMPLYING WITH THE TERMS OF THIS CONTRACT, I WILL PUT THE DATES OF THE ABOVE EVENTS IN MY 2010-2011 CALENDAR. IF I AM UNABLE TO FULFILL A COMMITMENT, I AM RESPONSIBLE FOR: (1) FINDING A REPLACEMENT, AND (2) RESCHEDULING MY COMMITMENT PRIOR TO THE ORIGINAL COMMITMENT.

I certify that I have in effect and will keep in effect during the coming year, automobile insurance (\$50,000/\$100,000/\$50,000 minimum) on the vehicle(s) used to transport Troop 35 Scouts.
