

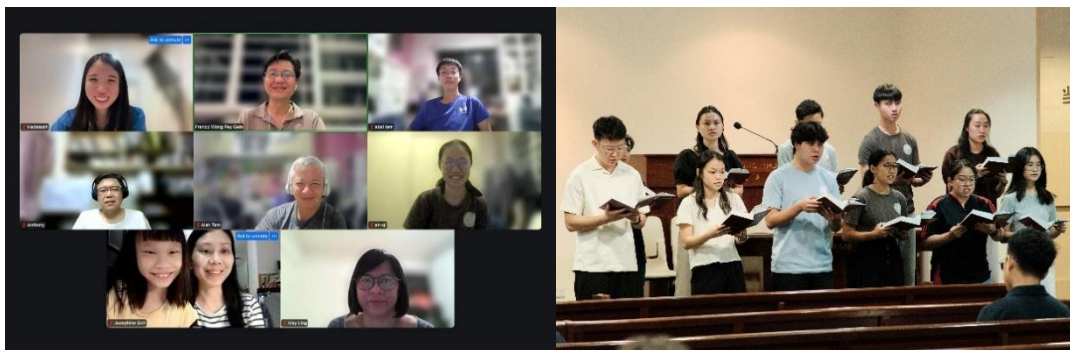
**Truth B-P Church**

### Message Key Points

The speaker, Rev Dr Quek Suan Yew, exhorted us from Psalm 135 to keep praising and rejoicing in the Lord inwardly regardless of the outward situations we may be in. This can only come when we have a genuine and personal relationship with the LORD. Just like how the Psalmist truly had joy in his heart as he praised the Lord and experienced God's presence, we ought to keep a very close walk with the LORD after our salvation and know that we are always in God's presence.

Our fellowship groups cater to different ages. The different age groups have different challenges: YFers face overwhelming pressure in studies; YAFers have to deal with work stress, marriage and the whole weight of adulthood; while AFers face health issues, etc. As such, the different fellowship groups were born to help us spiritually. Looking back, Truth BPC was also born of God, just like how Israel as a nation was born of God and brought out of Egypt. Our Almighty God also brought our leaders out and put all of us together here in the different fellowship groups to be a church witness, to encourage, to praise and to rejoice in all that He has done for us. Do we have memories of our praises to God, of our worship

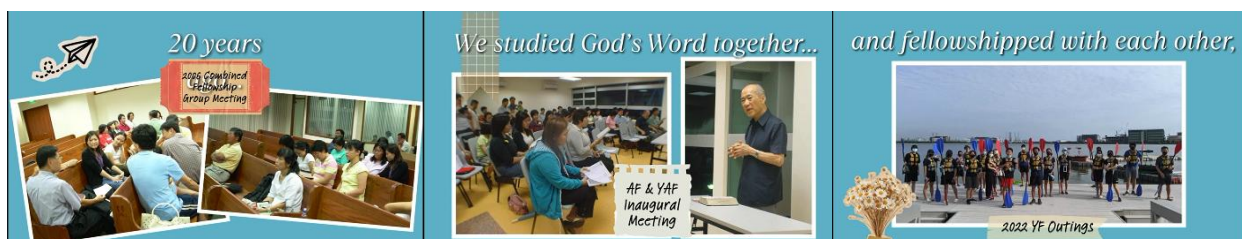

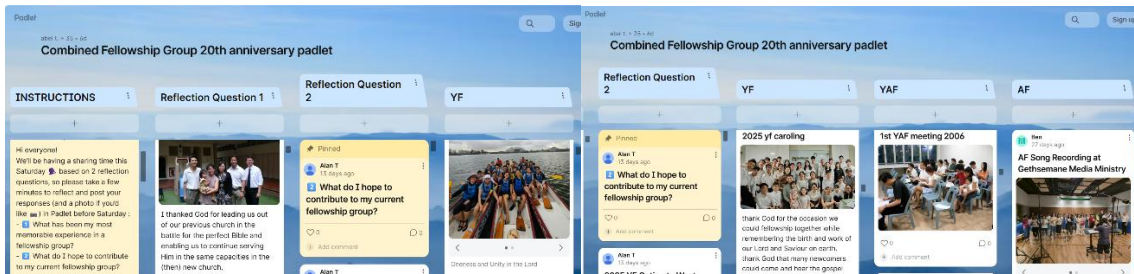
