- Lawful between consenting parties.
- o Marriage of Believers
 - Marry only in the Lord.
 - Not to marry unbelievers.
 - Not to marry professing believers that are notoriously wicked or heretics.
- 4. Marriage ought not to be within the degrees of consanguinity or affinity forbidden in the word;⁸ nor can such incestuous marriages ever be made lawful by any law of man, or consent of parties, so as those persons may live together as man and wife.⁹ v

In the case of adultery after marriage, it is lawful for the innocent party to sue out a divorce, and, after the divorce, to marry another, as if the offending party were dead.

Although the corruption of man be such as is apt to study arguments, unduly to put asunder those whom God hath joined together in marriage; yet nothing but adultery, or such wilful desertion as can no way be remedied by the church or civil magistrate, is cause sufficient of dissolving the bond of marriage; wherein a public and orderly course of proceeding is to be observed, and the persons concerned in it not left to their own wills and discretion in their own case. 14
