# CHAPTER 24: OF MARRIAGE AND DIVORCE

- 1. MARRIAGE is to be between one man and one woman: neither is it lawful for any man to have more than one wife, nor for any woman to have more than one husband at the same time.<sup>1</sup>

It is lawful for all sorts of people to marry who are able with judgment to give their consent; 5 yet it is the duty of Christians to marry only in the Lord. 6 And therefore such as profess the true reformed religion should not marry with infidels or other idolaters; neither should such as are godly be unequally yoked, by marrying with such as are notoriously wicked in their life, or maintain damnable heresies. 7

  - Marriage of Unbelievers
    - Lawful between consenting parties.
  - Marriage of Believers
    - Marry only in the Lord.
    - Not to marry unbelievers.
    - Not to marry professing believers that are notoriously wicked or heretics.
  - 4. Marriage ought not to be within the degrees of consanguinity or affinity forbidden in the word; nor can such incestuous marriages ever be made lawful by any law of man, or consent of parties, so as those persons may live together as man and wife. 9 v
