

Camp Master Writes...

Dear Campers,

From ages past, the apostles and prophets have set for us a basic pattern and example to follow in evangelism- through words, in the form of speech. Every Christian ought to know that he does not need to have the golden tongue of Chrysostom, nor the oratorical brilliance of Spurgeon, to share the faith with others. All that Christ requires of us is a willing heart to stand for the truth, and to yield himself to be used by the Lord.

This camp does not seek to turn one into an eloquent speaker overnight, but to essentially equip the Christian with the knowledge of other denominations, and as well as prominent philosophies held by others out in the streets, whom one would meet in every day life. It would not be possible to comprehensively cover every denomination or philosophy that one might encounter, but in the selected messages covering the more common denominations, the Christian youth would have an idea of what principles or beliefs each group would hold to. This knowledge would aid the youth in understanding the person he is sharing to, having an idea of what he might expect, and perhaps to prepare in his mind with the Spirit's help, to find different ways to approach and discuss key issues.

Through interaction and discussion also, God willing, we might be able to share our experiences, our mistakes, and testimonies of how God might have used us to share with others about our faith. Recently, by the grace of God, I have able to share with a Christian former-schoolmate about our faith. He has been brought to many different Churches by his friends, and few were able to give reasonable explanations in their beliefs and practices that were held in their Churches. With a sincerely seeking heart that found little answer from Christian friends or groups, he eventually drifted away from all Christian fellowship with them.

It is our prayer that none of us would not be found in a similar circumstance, where we would be unable to give an answer to what we take a stand in, or in our practices. Hence, the question is posed to us, are we tongue-tied when our faith is questioned or under persecution? May we be found ready.

The theme verse comes to mind- "But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear." 1 Peter 3:15

Quiet Time

"Buy the truth and sell it not" Prov 23:23

INSTRUCTION "ALSO WISDOM AND AND UNDERSTANDING." Especially you need the truth. It is necessary to enlighten the mind, sanctify the heart, cheer the soul, and regulate the life. All goodness flows from truth and all evil from error. Therefore buy the truth. It is to be had but it must be bought. It will cost you something to obtain it, but you cannot pay too much for it. It has fetched a very high price; some have given their liberty, their comforts and their lives for it. It is in God's book as gold in a mine. It is in Christ's person as its centre and source. Labour in the mine. Study Christ. Be diligent, industrious and determined to have the truth. Pray and strive for it. Honour the Holy Spirit who alone can put you in possession of it. It is His office to teach the truth: He leads into it, by degrees, by exercise, by sanctified means. Having bought the truth, never sell it. No one can bid a sufficient price for it. You can find no substitute for it. You will be sure to need it, to direct you in perplexity, to comfort you in sickness, to cheer you in sorrow, and to support you in death. Pleasure may bid for it. Honour may bid for it. Wealth may bid for it. But sell it not. Study it, profess it, and enjoy it.
