A time of question-and-answer was also available for the participants to seek clarification or to seek answers on how to deal with real situations they have faced or may face. As the

conference topics dealt with issues that are controversial and divisive, we thank God for giving Bro Samuel the grace and the wisdom to respond to such tough questions.

As the Conference was held via livestream, there was no discussion, but reflection questions were included in the conference booklet for us to ponder upon the impact of God's Word in our own lives, the situations that we may personally face and how we can respond biblically.

This year's Conference is a unique one (due to the implications of COVID-19) not just for the participants but for the Organising Committee as well. We had planned for a normal physical Conference, just like the many past CYCs, right up to February 2020. Even when the circuit breaker kicked in, we had hoped that by June things would return to normal. As it turned out, God has His plans. Not knowing when the government would lift the restrictions, as the situation was so unpredictable (to us), affected our Committee's planning. As a result, much of how the Conference should be run was decided less than a month before the Conference started.
