## Truth B-P Church Evangelism Workshop 2025

Thank God for the annual church evangelism workshop held to remind God's people of the Great Commission and to equip us with the necessary skills to do the work of evangelism. This year's evangelism workshop was held on 1 May 2025 (Thurs), from 8.30am to 1.30pm, in Room 0205, Calvary Pandan BPC. Rev Dr Jose Lagapa was the Lord's messenger, and he exhorted from Philippians 1:27 on the topic, "Is My Life the Gospel of Christ?"



Having received salvation, we were exhorted to live out our faith and let our conversation (i.e. conduct) be "as it becometh the gospel of Christ" (Phil 1:27a). Rev Lagapa reminded us of the importance of being a holy witness for Christ and, collectively as a church, how we must "stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel" (Phil 1:27b).

After the exhortation from God's Word, workshop participants were divided into groups to share among themselves commonly encountered questions

(pertaining to other religions) that they find difficult to answer during evangelism or in their conversation with others. Each group had to attempt to answer three of these questions in light of Scripture. The questions and answers contributed by each group were then presented on screen for others to see and learn. Thank God for the perfectly inspired and preserved Word of God that gives us answers to questions pertaining to eternal life, and helps us discern truth from falsehoods. May the Lord help us to know His Word well, and be convicted of His truth, that we may be ready always to give an answer to every man that asks us for a reason of the hope that is in us.

A concurrent children's programme was held for children aged four to nine, and Mrs Eileen Khoo taught the children from the same Bible passage. Thank God that the children could join the adults for a tracting session after Rev Lagapa concluded the workshop activity for the adults. We had the opportunity, once again, to give out tracts, particularly the newly published "Only Jesus Saves!" tract, to the residents in the Pandan Gardens neighbourhood, and to share the Gospel to some who had not heard. Thank God also for the opportunity to give out the Church Gospel Night invite and to invite professing believers

we met during the tracting session to join our Lord's Day worship. After about an hour of tracting, we gathered back for a debrief before lunch and were encouraged to hear of the work the Lord enabled His people to do during the tracting session.
