

Truth B-P Church
Report of Missions Trip to Cambodia (27 to 31 Mar 2026)

We thank the Lord for the opportunity He had given us to embark on this missions trip to Cambodia. The missions team comprised Rev Dennis Kwok, Ernest Kwok, Hadassah Chew, Wong En-Qi, Toh Yih Chern and myself. The objectives of this trip are as follows:

1. To rejoice with True Faith BPC's brethren on their 14th Anniversary.
2. To conduct Children's Sunday School at their outreaches and a Youth Gospel Meeting (ministries of True Faith BPC).
3. To conduct Home Visitations at Kampot (ministry of True Faith BPC).
4. To visit True Faith BPC's new church building project.
5. To make a trip to Sihanoukville (SHV) to visit:
(a) Agape BPC's newly renovated building, and (b) Lively Hope BPC.
6. To encourage the Cambodian preachers, families and church members.

We are thankful to the Lord that, by His grace, all the objectives listed above had been fulfilled.

Day 1 – Friday, 27 Mar

The missions team took a late morning flight from Changi Airport to Phnom Penh, the capital city of Cambodia. We arrived in the afternoon where we were warmly received by Pr Rotha and Sis Saron at the airport. We then commenced our three-hour journey to Kampot to check-in at the Kampot Coco Guesthouse before we had our first dinner fellowship with Pr Rotha and Sis Saron at a local stall. By nightfall, we visited True Faith BPC and had our evening devotion. To prepare our hearts to serve the Lord, Rev Dennis shared from 1 Timothy 4:12 as a reminder for us to be an example to other believers in everything we do: in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith and in purity. We had a good time of fellowship before returning to the guesthouse for our night's rest.



Day 2 – Saturday, 28 Mar

We began the day with morning devotion led by Rev Dennis to prepare our hearts for a day of service. Our first stopover was at True Gospel BPC (TGBPC). There we met with Pr Sopheak, Sis Thavy and family who shared with us the Lord's work at TGBPC. We had the opportunity to see the newly rented compound of TGBPC.



Late morning, we began our first home visitation to the home of Mdm Sarom (a widow) and her grandson. Rev Dennis shared Psalm 27:1 with her to encourage her to look to the Lord for her strength, light and salvation. Mdm Sarom also shared how she had to live with the little that she had and continues to labour as a clothes washer to make a living. She testified of God's goodness to her in her life. Although she struggled to make ends meet, the Lord provided for all her needs.



Our second home visitation was with Mdm Ung Chan Than, whose family members are unbelievers. Dn Anthony shared God's Word from Romans 3:23, Romans 5:8 and John 3:16 with the gospel message of salvation through Jesus Christ alone as our perfect sacrifice. Mdm Ung shared that her husband is an unbeliever and was not prepared to give up his drinking habit. We pray that by God's mercy, her husband and family will one day come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Our third home visitation was with 65-year-old Mdm Somul, a widow. Rev Dennis shared from Proverbs 3:5-6 to encourage her to trust in the Lord for His sustaining grace. Then, she shared how she struggled with her day-to-day living from the little that she has. She used to work as a cleaner at a pharmacy, but lost her job during the recent economic downturn. She is currently working as a cleaner at a nearby restaurant with no pay, only to survive from love gifts given by goodwill customers. As she can clean the compound only after all the restaurant customers have left, she often returns home after midnight. With the little that she has, she prays that God will sustain her.

All the three ladies we visited are members of Truth Faith BPC. It is our prayer that the Lord will grant them the faith to trust and depend on Him for their daily provision.



After the home visitations, we returned to Truth Faith BPC for lunch, prepared lovingly for us by Sis Saron. There we got to hear from Pr Rotha and Sis Saron how the Lord has blessed their work and ministries at True Faith BPC. After lunch, we proceeded to visit Truth Faith BPC's new church building which was still under construction. We thank God for the progress of the building construction works which are clearly seen in the photos below.



At about 5 pm, we returned to True Faith BPC for the Youth Gospel meeting. Rev Dennis preached the gospel message "God Loves You" (Rom 6:23) which was translated by Pr Rotha into Khmer. A total of about 24 youths (mainly from the English classes) turned up for the gospel meeting. When asked about their faith, most of them professed to be believers, but there are some who are uncertain of their faith. Rev Dennis ended the message with a gospel call to receive Jesus Christ. After the gospel meeting, the youths had a blessed time of fellowship over refreshments. Later in the evening, we had our dinner before returning to the guesthouse for our night's rest.



Day 3 – Lord’s Day, 29 Mar

The Lord’s Day began with morning devotion led by Rev Dennis. Then we had our breakfast before meeting with Pr Rotha who brought us to four different outreaches for the Sunday School Children’s Outreach Ministry. The first two outreaches are at Kep Tmey and Kampung Bai, while the last two are at Kampung Kreng. Hadassah shared “The Parable of the Sower” at these outreaches. She explained to the children that a “parable” was an earthly story with a heavenly meaning. In this parable, a sower went forth to sow. Some seeds fell on the wayside, some on stony places, some on thorns, and some on good ground. The four grounds represented the four different types of hearers. Hadassah ended the sharing with an invitation to the children to accept Jesus Christ as their Saviour and to be like the good ground.



The second part of the Children’s Outreach Ministry was the craft-making activity where the children folded the craft with an image of the four different types of ground. Ernest, En-Qi and Yih Chern helped the children with their craft-making activities. We thank God that the objective of the activity was met, the children did the craft well and many of them acknowledged to believe in Jesus Christ.



At about 4 pm, we rejoiced and commemorated with True Faith BPC on their 14th Anniversary. We thank God about 38 adults and 21 children attended the commemorative worship service. The service was conducted by Pr Rotha (chairman) while Rev Dennis preached the message “Looking unto Jesus” (Heb 12:1-4). The focus of the message was for every believer to look unto Jesus as they run their race. The race is for every believer, and all believers are to finish the race well. The message was translated by Pr Rotha into Khmer. Rev Dennis conducted the Lord’s Supper, while Pr Rotha served the bread and the cup. There were three hymn presentations. The first two hymns were presented in Khmer by the local older and younger brethren: “Revive Us Again” and “Bringing in the Sheaves.” The third hymn was by our missions team “Amazing Grace”. En-Qi played the piano for the service, and Ernest played the piano for our missions team presentation. After the service, dinner (lovingly prepared by Pr Rotha’s family) was served to all. It was a joyous occasion for everyone. We had a blessed time of fellowship with one another, and we thank God for sustaining True Faith BPC these past 14 years.



After dinner when all the guest have left, Rev Dennis ended the night with evening devotion. After that, Pr Rotha gave everyone an opportunity to share their thoughts and blessings. As this was likely to be True Faith BPC’s last anniversary service at this rented house, we thank God for His faithfulness in sustaining True Faith BPC for these past 14 years at this same rented house. We look forward to the next anniversary in the new church building. We spent the remaining hours of the night rejoicing and fellowshiping with one another before returning to our guesthouse for our night’s rest.

Day 4 – Monday, 30 Mar

The day started with morning devotion led by Rev Dennis. Pr Rotha, Sis Saron, Pr Sopheak and Sis Thavy joined us for the morning fellowship before sending us off to the Kampot Railway Station at 10.45 am. There we waited for about an hour before the train arrived. The train journey was pleasant. It took us more than two hours before we arrived at the Sihanoukville train station. Upon arrival, we were warmly received by Pr John Saray and Sis Lydia. There we proceeded to have our lunch before we checked-in at the Don Bosco Hotel School. Before nightfall, Pr John drove us to 80-Roofs village to visit Agape BPC, Pr Bun Kouy and his family. We were warmly received by Pr Bun Kouy's family. He brought us around to see his newly renovated church compound. We thank God for sustaining the renovated work and for the speedy completion of the newly renovated works at Agape BPC. There we had our last evening devotion led by Rev Dennis. For the rest of the evening, we had a blessed time of fellowship with Pr Bun Kouy and family until about 10 pm when we decided we had to take our leave and to return to Don Bosco Hotel School for our night's rest.



Day 5 – Tuesday, 31 Mar

At 8.30 am, Pr John came to fetch us to Lively Hope BPC where we had the opportunity to visit the completed building. Then we took our leave to travel to the airport in Phnom Penh. We managed to have a quick breakfast at a local stall before continuing our three-hour journey from Sihanoukville to Phnom Penh Techo International Airport. We left with a sense of sadness, praying that we will meet again at the coming Truth BPC Bible Camp in June this year. We thank God for a blessed trip. May God continue to bless the Cambodian preachers, their families and their churches as they serve Him faithfully. Amen.

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
