Deut. 6:4-9

Hear, O Israel: Jehovah our God
is one Jehovah; and Thou shalt
love Jehovah thy God with all thy
heart, and with all thy soul, and
with all thy might.

And these words which I command
thee this day, shall be upon thy

heart; and thou shalt teach them ⁴
diligently unto thy children, and
shalt talk of them when thou sittest
in thy house, and when thou walkest
by the way, and when thou liest down,
and when thou risest up.

And thou shalt bind them for
a sign upon thy hand, and they

shalt be for growths between ⁵
thine eyes. And thou shalt write
them upon the door-posts of
thy house, and upon thy gates.

When Jesus was asked by a lawyer
to give the great commandment
he reduced the foregoing to,

6-2
"Thou shalt love the Lord thy
God with all thy heart, and with
all thy soul, and with all thy mind."

This is the great and first com-
mandment.

And a second like unto it, is
this, Thou shalt love thy neighbor
as thyself."
