At the Conference in June, packets were prepared for all who participated. Included in those packets were copies of pamphlets that are available to our ministries as a service of AUC. It was remarkable how many people at the time and subsequently have expressed surprise that these were available. All, of course, have been shared through CONTACT but obviously it is necessary for us to repeat this from time to time. We have available in the AUC office certain pamphlets that are available as a service to your ministry and the people you serve. Dating back prior to the formation of AUC, we still have available "Center Operation Handbook", a booklet on Changing Leadership, membership certificates and copies of the spiritual communion service. We make the Center Operation Handbook available to student ministers just prior to their entry into the field. From time to time, when there are serious questions as to the procedures involved, the booklet on Changing Leadership has proved helpful. Of course, the membership certificates and spiritual communion services have been used over and over by many of our centers.

To assist you and your staff in rendering service to the members of your congregation, we have produced two companion pamphlets, "Now That You Are In The Hospital" and "Now That You Are Home From The Hospital". These are especially created to enable you to remind those of your congregation, meeting this type of challenge, of your consciousness of prayer and the desire that you have for your ministry to extend and increase its service to them. "The Healing Quality of Grief" was originally designed to introduce new people to what Unity has to offer at a time of the loss of a loved one. Several of our ministries utilize this pamphlet in having a Committee send a copy to the family of those meeting bereavement as listed in the local newspaper. This proved a real blessing to many.

"Unity, a Ministry of Service" has proved to be an effective piece for mailing to your congregation from time to time and especially to the new names that appear on your mailing list. This pamphlet is available both in English and in Spanish. Your AUC office has also produced a pamphlet entitled "Guidelines for Unity Board Members." These, at the present time, are being reprinted but are particularly helpful in assisting Board Members to understand their responsibility to and relationship with the ministry and all of its facets. Please feel free to let us know if your ministry could benefit from the use of any of this material. We stand ready to be of service in this way.

Phillip M. Pierson, minister of Christ Unity Church of Sacramento, California, was recently named Executive Director of the Charles and Myrtle Fillmore Foundation succeeding Dr. H. LaMarr Rice, whose resignation became effective August 1. The announcement was made by Charles R. Fillmore, Chairman of the Board of Trus-

tees for the Foundation and Executive Vice-President of Unity School of Christianity.

A successful business career as well as extensive ministerial work in the Unity movement combine to give Phil an exceptionally fine background for his new assignment. After his graduation from Haverford College, Haverford, Pennsylvania, Phil became Refinery Sales Representative for the Ashland Oil and Refining Company. He then moved into the world of investment and finance as Regional Sales Manager for Standard & Poor's Corporation.

Phil was graduated from the Unity School for Ministerial and Religious Studies in 1959. During his two years at Unity School he also served as a Silent Unity worker. His first responsibility in the field was as Associate Minister of Unity Church of Truth, Seattle, Washington. This service was followed by assignments in Bellevue, Washington; Everett, Washington and Bellingham, Washington. In 1963, Phil and his wife, Dorothy became coministers of Unity Church of Hawaii.

The Piersons accepted responsibility for Christ Unity Church of Sacramento in 1967. The tremendous growth of that ministry with its spiritual and economic stability is a tribute to the Piersons' ministry as well as their fiscal skills.

Phil became a member of the Board of Trustees of the Association of Unity Churches in 1969. In 1970 he was elected Vice-President of the Association and served as its President from June 1970 until June 1971. He has been a member of the Board of Trustees of the Charles and Myrtle Fillmore Foundation for the past four and a half years.

Speaking for the Foundation Trustees, Charles Fillmore said, "We are delighted that Phil Pierson has accepted this new assignment in addition to his ministerial duties. He brings a high spiritual consciousness, a fine talent for financial management, and a great dedication to the Unity movement to the position."

REPORT

Bringing you up to date by way of a financial report to you, we are happy to share the fact that our general love offerings for the period April 1 through August 31 have been \$96,000.00. We have converted our Certificate of Deposit and transferred our funds from our Canadian account of \$23,000.00. We have billed \$8,500.00 for the sale of Youth Education Curriculum and materials which is a total of \$127,500.00. Our approximate expenses during this period of time have been: Inventory purchases (including new curriculum) \$12,500.00; our film (Involvement) \$8,500; Auditing Fees \$3,300.00; Emeritus payments, \$6,500.00; our tithe to our expansion and outreach activities \$9,600.00; payments to the Money Purchase Pension Plan \$9,000.00; Operating Expenses, approximately, \$8,800.00.

Our Bank status as of September 1 is \$23,000.00 in our banking account, \$14,000.00 of which is YOU Conference Deposit Money and \$9,000.00 is Money Purchase Pension Plan money. Our Tithe saving account is \$9,600.00. Our accounts payable are approximately \$7,000.00 but are less than 30 days old. As you can see, the cash on hand that we are holding is all earmarked, however, we have brought ourself up to a current position in our accounts payable and are now moving into a period of more positive financial stability. Traditionally, our income picks up in the fall months and we are beginning to benefit by the trimming of our expenditures during that period of time. We are not out of the woods yet, but we are well on the way. We would appreciate your continued consciousness of prayer with us as we all work toward a greater outreach through the AUC.

the growth of living cells are founded.


