#### Requirements:

- Must be a senior in high school
- Must apply and have been accepted to Tusculum
- Must have attended the Old Oak Workshops
- Must submit entry for consideration by the scholarship committee by April 10, 2019

Please submit reproductions of your work only. You may arrange to pick up your work after winners have been announced.

Please choose one submission from one of the categories below. We will only judge one submission. In celebration of Old Oak, we encourage you to let East Tennessee living influence your submissions.

**ENGLISH** Submit a short story, poem, or essay of no more than 1200 words.

**ART** Submit a drawing, painting, or collection of photography (3-9 images)—send us a high-quality photo or reproduction.

**THEATER** Write a short script (10 pages maximum), perform a 2-5 minute monologue and send us video, or write an essay detailing your interest in design and technical theater (1,000 word minimum).

**MUSIC** Send a video recording of the candidate performing a short piece of music (2-5 minutes). Pieces need not be original compositions.

## Art Sample (Please check which type you will be submitting)

### ENGLISH

- A short story (300-1200 words)
- Craft a poem
- Construct an essay (300-1200 words) defining the culture of East Tennessee and how that culture has influenced your life thus far.

### ART

- Produce a drawing (send us a high-quality photo or reproduction)
- Create a painting (photo or reproduction)
- Collate a collection of photography (3-9 images)

### THEATER

- Write a short script (10 pages maximum)
- Perform a 2-5 minute monologue from a play of your choice and submit video/DVD. (Please announce author and title of chosen play at the beginning of the video.)
- Write an essay detailing your interest in design and technical theater. (1,000 word minimum)

### MUSIC

- Send a video recording of candidate performing a short piece of music (2-5 minutes). Pieces need not be original compositions.
