

DSST Testing Packet

TESTING POLICIES:

1. Approval requests must be made at least **5 working days** in advance of the date you plan to test, whether you will test at Tusculum or another institution.

All students should contact Nancy Thompson at NThompson@tusculum.edu. In the subject line of the email, write "Testing Approval" and include the test(s) that you wish to take in the body of the email.

- **2.** Payment for the exam will be made at the time of testing, online, with a credit or debit card supplied by the student.
- **3.** All new and returning students that enrolled after August 1, 2009 may receive a <u>maximum</u> of 18 hours of proficiency credit (DSST, CLEP, etc.). All other students may receive up to 30 hours.
- **4.** Allow 2 hours per test for DSST. **You may only take one test per two hour testing slot**.

- 5. It can take up 7 to 10 weeks from the date of taking the exam to receive your official scores at the college. Passing results will be posted to the student's transcript when the score is received and will be available to view on WebAdvisor under **Test** Summary.
- **6.** If you are enrolled, or plan to enroll, for a course that could possibly duplicate an approved exam, please contact Nancy Thompson immediately for another file review.
- **7.** Because of the multiple ways you have for earning additional core/elective hours, <u>approvals for exams are only valid for 60 days</u>.
- **8.** A student must wait **30 days (one month)** before retaking a DSST exam that was not passed.
- **9.** If testing at another school, be sure to give <u>8590</u> as the score recipient code.

3 STEPS TO TAKING AN EXAM:

STEP 1: GET APPROVAL

STEP 3: PAY FEE

Payment of \$85 for DSST (internet-based testing) must be made at time of testing by credit/debit card ONLY (Visa, MC or AMEX). Your credit card will be verified by your address. You must supply the billing address where your credit card statements are received or the transaction may be declined.

ON THE DAY OF THE EXAM:

- 1. Arrive on time.
- 2. You **MUST** have your Tusculum College ID with you (current students) or unexpired ID/military ID for non-students or fully-funded military.
- 3. Do not bring hats, books, an alarm watch that beeps, a calculator that beeps, a cell phone, or any other electronic devices into the testing room.
- 4. No food is allowed during testing due to the distractions it causes other exam takers.
- 5. A pen and official scratch paper will be provided for you during testing.
- 6. Please limit the number of times you leave the testing center.

PREPARING FOR A DSST:

There are many ways to study for a DSST exam. **Please look around for the options that would work best for you.**

<u>Tusculum College cannot advise you in any one way to prepare for the exam and we do not endorse any particular website that sells study guides.</u> <u>DSST will update the content of their exams as needed and third-party study-guide providers may not be aware of these changes.</u>

Please note that these exams are difficult and are meant to cover a semester of a college course work.

Official DSST Test Preparation Guides are available at the Tusculum College Bookstore and offer <u>sample</u> exam questions and an <u>overview</u> of material, but these are designed to give you an understanding of the test material, not to fully prepare you for the exam.

The DSST exam provider also has fact sheets that outline the topics covered by each exam and include a list of sample questions and recommended book references. You can download and print fact sheets from www.getcollegecredit.com by clicking on the **Test Takers** tab at the top and **choosing Exam Fact Sheets.**

DSST also provides Online Practice Tests for a fee that contain 20-25 sample questions. These are also available at www.getcollegecredit.com and can be found by clicking on the **Test Takers** tab at the top and choosing **Test Preparation.** Military personnel and their families can use either the Petersons Practice Tests or the Prometric Practice Tests. All other students will use the Prometric Practice Tests.
