





Bullard Jones served

here from September 1961 until March 1967. Bro. Jones implemented and taught a New Member Orientation class. Sign language classes were offered, and Teacher Training classes were offered to train prospective Sunday School teachers.

This was a boom period for church growth. The church received a total of 783 members during Bro. Jones' ministry here. A "paving fund" was begun to improve the parking lot. We also celebrated our 25th Anniversary as a church.

A second secretary was employed for two days a week @ \$10 a day.

Bro. & Mrs. Jones went to Okinawa as missionaries for one week during a Japanese Crusade in the mid 1960's.
