

PASTOR'S PARAGRAPH...

Dear Church Family,

Sunday was another example of the Gospel at work across the spectrum of FBC Bridge City. We were able to have a powerful worship time together and extended it through the fellowship meal afterwards. We were even able to share our meal with homebound members. How does all of this come together?

Sunday worship starts early in the week. As the songs and order are set after thoughtful prayer and consideration of the message, the musicians and singers begin preparing. They show up on Sunday morning before others and work through the music and do final rehearsals. The music team is not alone though. The sound booth is being manned and last minute adjustments are being made. If I have been faithful to my task, the message has been lightly studied and prayed over during the course of the week. Friday generally is my sermon preparation day and I will spend additional hours doing background reading and researching additional sources. Then the sermon marinates and is finalized prayerfully Saturday. During the service, the nursery is caring for babies and young toddlers. Children's church is underway through volunteers ministering to the children. Sunday meals start on Saturday with hours of cooking and prepping being finished on Sunday. Teams come after Sunday School and pickup meals to be delivered during the worship time. People are giving up being a part of the worship service to serve others. After the service, the whole of the church is able to enjoy a meal together though geographically separated. Why do I share all this? Humility is the fuel for the Gospel and all that we do within the church.

Sunday we continue our study in Philippians, "The Joy of the Gospel", by highlighting the text, Phil. 2:12-18. Paul after encouraging them to engrain humility into their lives, speaks of the witness a humble life bears. Our salvation in Christ is certain and set, but our living it is a daily work we undergo. Complaining is easy and natural. No person needs to be taught how to be pessimistic. We who are recipients of the Gospel, must train ourselves to see the joy in all things. Being joyful and optimistic bears a witness of Christ and that we truly believe He is in control. What is your common demeanor? Are you being a positive or negative witness for Christ?


PASTOR'S PARAGRAPH . . . (continued)
