PASTOR'S PARAGRAPH ...

Dear Church Family,

We have, over the past months, had the privilege to work through Philippians together and rediscover the "Joy of the Gospel." The Gospel is the means of our salvation and also our growth in Christ. The world is desperate for the truth of the Gospel though they know not what they are needing. We are the God ordained delivery system for communicating the message. We may not be able to change the world, but by sharing the Gospel with someone you know just might change their world. Look for the opportunities God is providing for you to share in "word and deed."

Sunday we launch into a new series covering the Ten Commandments, "God Speaks: Words for Then and Now." We will be doing an intro by looking at Exodus 19. 
