Dear Church Family,

Thank you church for providing a warm welcome and response to Billy Manning. I pray you were blessed by his impactful message and call to an authentic faith in Christ. Our team, John Woods and Darrell Segura, had a great time of worship at Oakwood Baptist. Continue to pray for Billy and Oakwood Baptist as they walk by faith following God's leading.

Sunday we return to our sermon series, "Faith that Moves Mountains", by looking at the Parable of the Sower in Matthew 13:1-23. The parable is a familiar one but not always easily understood. Thankfully Jesus provides a rare candid explanation to the parable. A farmer is about the task of preparing for the next season of crops. In doing so, he spreads the seed broadly. The seed falls on four different soils each with a unique response to the seed. Only one type of soil produced actual fruit. The others had the seed snatched away or die out after taking root. Jesus upon sharing the parable with the people states, "He who has ears, let him hear."

Jesus classifies the soil by the response to hearing the Word. Those who hear the Word and do the Word produce fruit. They demonstrate faith, which is trust plus obedience. They have a faith with ears, ready and listening for God's Word so they may obey which thereby produces abundant fruit. Does your faith have ears? Are you eagerly waiting to hear the Word of God?

The Sunday Night Classes are off to a great start. Even if you missed last week, just jump in and be blessed by being challenged in hearing God's Word. FBCBC is where the "impossible" is a living reality every day. Invite others to join with you in living out the "impossible" at FBCBC.
