Day 1

Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-13

Day 4

Read 1 Corinthians 1:4-8; 16:15-16

What was Stephanas' household devoted to?

The Bible calls this the gift of service—Anything we do motivated by the Love of Jesus.

Who were they serving?

All believers can use the gift of service to channel God's love to others.

"Sitting down, Jesus called the Twelve and said, 'If anyone wants to be first, he must be the very last, and the servant of all.'" Mark 9:35

Pray about where Jesus wants you to serve others in the body of Christ.

Give It Up For God

Day 5

Read 2 Corinthians 8:1-5; 9:6-15

"Giving" is a Bible word describing *a person's deliberate parting with possessions so that a change of ownership is brought about.*

What condition were these "giving" believers in? Why didn't that affect their using the gift of giving? What do you think about that?

2 Corinthians 9:8—who replenishes our supply to give when we obey? Do you trust Him enough to care for your own needs as you give to others?

In verses 11-12 what is our purpose in giving?
