Salvation Present

Day 1

Read Romans 5:6-11. Memorize Romans 5:10

There are three aspects of salvation—Past, Present, Future. Fill in the blanks:

Saved by His Life

Day 2

Read Hebrews 2:14-15, 18; 4:14-16.

What does 4:16 say we are able to do because of Jesus? Stop now and ask God boldly to give you the strength to resist temptation. Thank Him for what He will do.

Victory in the Spirit

Day 3

Read Ephesians 5:17-18. Quote Romans 5:10 from memory.

In the Greek vs. 18 is a command with ongoing consequences. Literally it means: You are ordered to be continually filled with the Spirit.

This is a daily process of your Salvation Present. You are not only saved by the *death* of Jesus, but also by the *life* of Jesus.

Working Out What God is Working In

Day 4

Read **Philippians 2:5-13; Hebrews 13:20-21.**

What do these verses say about the power of Jesus and His desire to be at “work” in our lives?

Jesus is in the *highest place* and He is *Lord*. Jesus accomplished everything necessary for our salvation. But Paul then says: Work out your salvation with fear and trembling.

Does that mean we should be afraid of losing what Jesus has done for us? No way. It means we are responsible to choose to follow Him daily. If we are afraid it is fear of missing out on His activity and His purpose in our daily lives. Let Him be fully in charge of your personality and life today.

Salvation is Rescue

Day 5

Read **Colossians 1:9-14.**

Salvation began when God drew you to Jesus and you confessed your sin and your faith in Jesus as Lord. You are now free from sin’s power by the life of Jesus in you. In a future final event Jesus will free you from your old sin nature.

You were rescued from drowning in your sin. you could not save yourself. Salvation is God rescuing us from our sinful life and placing us in His kingdom and filling us with His life. He makes it possible for you to live a Christ-filled life. Awesome isn’t it?

What kind of things do these Bible verses say we can expect as normal Christian living that God will provide.? Let’s stop and ask for these things right now.
