

# Advent

## A Tradition of Anticipation

This Christmas season we will observe the traditional practice of Advent each Sunday leading up to Christmas Day. Two questions may come to mind, what is advent and what does it mean to me?

Advent comes from the Latin word *adventus*, which means "coming" or "visit. During the season of advent, we keep our mind focused on both "advents" of Christ, the first in Bethlehem and the second yet to come. In Advent, we're reminded of how much we ourselves need a Savior, and we look forward to the Savior's second coming even as we prepare to celebrate his first coming at Christmas.

Advent is a season of preparation and a time of expectant waiting with anticipation. It causes us to direct our focus on the Christ of Christmas and away from the secular trappings of materialism that is saturating our world culture today. Waiting is something we all must do and the thing we hate the most. However, waiting for the right thing, for the right reason, and in the right way, can be a joyful time. Advent helps us focus our "waiting" on Christ.

The lighting of the candles in the Advent wreath, accompanied with Scripture, reminds us of love, joy, hope, and peace--things that are longed for by many during this season, yet are only found in Jesus Christ! I hope that Advent will be a meaningful experience for you and draw you closer to Christ in a way you have never experienced before!
