Colossians 1:1-14

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by God's will,
and Timothy our brother: To the saints and
faithful brothers in Christ in Colossae. Grace to
you and peace from God our Father. We always
thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
when we pray for you, for we have heard of
your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you
have for all the saints

because of the hope reserved for you in heaven. You have already heard about this hope in the message of truth, the gospel that has come to you. It is bearing fruit and growing all over the world, just as it has among you since the day you heard it and recognized God's grace in the truth.

You learned this from Epaphras, our much loved fellow slave. He is a faithful minister of the Messiah on your behalf, and he has told us about your love in the Spirit. For this reason also, since the day we heard this, we haven't stopped praying for you. We are asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding,

so that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully
pleasing to Him, bearing fruit in every good
work and growing in the knowledge of God.

May you be strengthened with all power,
according to His glorious might, for all
endurance and patience, with joy giving thanks
to the Father, who has enabled you to share in
the saints' inheritance in the light.

He has rescued us from the domain of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of the Son He loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.
