# Aaron, the Prophet

A Levite, the descendant of Levi & Moses' older brother (Ex. 4:14)

Called to be Moses mouth piece (Ex. 4:27-28)

Confronted Pharaoh with Moses (Ex.6:26-7:13)

Held the staff during 3 of the 7 plagues & helped with a 4<sup>th</sup> (Ex. 7:19, 8:5, 8:16, 9:8, 10:3)

Later became the Head of the Priesthood (Ex.28:1)

# Do You have Stumbling Blocks in Your Life?

Woe to the world because of offenses. For offenses must come, but woe to that man by whom the offense comes. If your hand or your foot causes your downfall, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life maimed or lame, than to have two hands or two feet and be thrown into the eternal fire. And if your eye causes your downfall, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life with one eye, rather than to have two eyes and be thrown into hellfire! -Matthew 18:7-9

# Are You a Stumbling Block to Others?

But be careful that this right of yours in no way becomes a stumbling block to the weak. For if somebody sees you, the one who has this knowledge, dining in an idol's temple, won't his weak conscience be encouraged to eat food offered to idols? Then the weak person, the brother for whom Christ died, is ruined by your knowledge. Now when you sin like this against the brothers and wound their weak conscience, you are sinning against Christ. Therefore, if food causes my brother to fall, I will never again eat meat, so that I won't cause my brother to fall. -1 Corinthians 8:9-13
