# **Barnabas: the Example of Service (Acts 4:36-37)**

- **Real name= Joseph meaning “exalted”**
- **A Levite (Jew) born in Cyprus (Gentile)**
- **Earned the nick-named Barnabas. Meaning “son of rest or encouragement”**
- **Sold a field, brought the money to the disciples to be distributed to the poor among them.**
- **Used in contrast to Ananias & Sapphira (Acts 5)**
