


# PROPHECIES OF JESUS





# THE VIRGIN BIRTH

Isaiah 7:10-25/ Matthew 1:18-25,  
Luke 1:26-38 & Galatians 3:27-4:7

For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. There is no Jew or Greek, slave or free, male or female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus. And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, heirs according to the promise. Now I say that as long as the heir is a child, he differs in no way from a slave, though he is the owner of

everything. Instead, he is under guardians and stewards until the time set by his father. In the same way we also, when we were children, were in slavery under the elemental forces of the world. But when the completion of the time came, God sent His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those under the law, so that we might receive

adoption as sons. And because you are sons,  
God has sent the Spirit of His Son into our  
hearts, crying, “Abba , Father!” So you are no  
longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then an  
heir through God.

# **The Old Testament Prophecy**

## **The Context (Isaiah 7)**

### **The Prophecy (Isaiah 7:14-16)**

- **An unmarried woman will conceive and give birth to a son**
  - **His name will be Immanuel, meaning God with Us**
- **By the time He is grown, the land he feared will be empty**

# The Gospels

## Gabriel visits Mary (Luke 1:26-38)

- Mary was a “favored woman”
- He will have a forever kingdom
- “Can’t happen because I’m a virgin”- Mary
  - Mary was obedient

## An Angel visits Joseph (Matthew 1:18-25)

- “I have to put Mary away she is pregnant” –Joseph
- “Son of David (*House of David*) this prophecy fulfilled”
  - Joseph was obedient

# The Letters

- **When the time came (v.4)**
  - **Born of a woman**
  - **Born under the law**
- **To redeem those under the law (v.5)**
  - **To adopt those who were not sons**

# Why is the “*Virgin Birth*” Important?

- It is a sign for the House of David
- This Son was going to be among us  
(John 1:14)
- He was going to have an eternal kingdom
- The virgin is a sign of hope that God has not forgotten us
