On behalf of the orphaned children at our ministry, we wish to send to you our sincere thanks and gratitude for the donations which the generous Baptist churches in Smith County have graciously made for the cause of underprivileged children and poor families in Leogane, Haiti. The donations are as follow: a 2010 Ford E-350 passenger van, an amount of over \$4000.00 (to be used to pay for shipping, US customs' inspection, Haiti's customs/taxes, insurance and registration's fees) and many other items such as: shoes, sneakers, clothes, paint, generator, tools, computers, sewing machines, soap, sheets, tooth brushes, school supplies, etc...
 From the initiator of the movement, Valerie McCord, who used out of pocket money to buy the van, the Director of Mission, Pastor David Hays who embraced the idea, Pastor Ronny Moseley who helped pay for fuel to drive the vehicle to Florida, Mr. Russ and Mr. Tommy who took time out of their busy schedule to bring the van to West Palm Beach, to all my other brothers and sisters who donated money, time and energy to help materializing the dream, my hat is off.

I know how expensive buying all these items could have been. I want to thank those of you who gave the clothes and those who collected and packed them. It was no picnic putting these things together.
