



## GETTING BACK TO THE CHURCH

### THAT WORKS!

This week we were in Acts 5 and we looked at verses 1-16, as we witnessed the first incident of hypocrisy introduced into the church. We saw the problem revealed from a couple, Ananias and Sapphira, who conceived an idea that Satan had sewn in their hearts. We saw in chapter four some spontaneous generosity from a man named Barnabas who gave some property and laid all the proceeds at the disciples' feet for God's glory. That incident is probably what gave this couple the idea; nothing from the apostles or the church was issued that you must give all your property away. They could have said we are giving this land but feel we need to keep some of the proceeds back for ourselves. Instead, they lied to God, not just man. Acts 5:1-5 *"But a man named Ananias, with his wife Sapphira, sold a piece of property, <sup>2</sup> and with his wife's knowledge he kept back for himself some of the proceeds and brought only a part of it and laid it at the apostles' feet. <sup>3</sup> But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and to keep back for yourself part of the proceeds of the land? <sup>4</sup> While it remained unsold, did it not remain your own? And after it was sold, was it not at your disposal? Why is it that you have contrived this deed in your heart? You have not lied to man but to God." <sup>5</sup> When Ananias heard these words, he fell down and breathed his last. And great fear came upon all who heard of it." (ESV)* In verse 9 we see the same consequence for Sapphira. *But Peter said to her, "How is it that you have agreed together to test the Spirit of the Lord? Behold, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out." (ESV)* What was the effect on the church as they witnessed the Holy Spirit's immediate judgment upon this couple? Acts 5:11-14 *"And great fear came upon the whole church and upon all who heard of these things. <sup>12</sup> Now many signs and wonders were regularly done among the people by the hands of the apostles. And they were all together in Solomon's Portico. <sup>13</sup> None of the rest dared join them, but the people held them in high esteem. <sup>14</sup> And more than ever believers were added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women. (ESV)* The power was restored back to this church as it was purged from hypocrites within. The people were filled with great awe and respect; you don't play games with the Lord God. God is gracious, long-suffering and full of mercy, but He also is a God who desires sincerity from His people who profess they know Him!

I pray God grows us and uses us to be the church that works among ourselves, in south OKC and Moore, and across the globe to live out examples of the change that He brings about in us that we might earn a platform to share how they can know Him too! Let's strive to love Him with all of our heart, mind, soul and strength, (Matthew 22:36-38). I look forward to seeing you this Lord's day. Love my church family.
