

God Give Us Christian Men

Read Jeremiah 5:1-6

Every home needs a strong symbol of authority. The father cannot be all he ought to be as a father and as a man unless he knows Jesus Christ as Savior.

God give us men of conviction.

As we look at our world we see deterioration on every hand. We see people who once had deep convictions concerning right and wrong have yielded to compromise and sacrificed principles.

In our homes we need fathers who have convictions concerning the great issues of life and practice them in daily living. Men like Joshua who will say, "As for me and my house we will serve God".

God give us men of compassion.

To be strong and uncompromising is not enough to make an ideal father or husband. We need men who are tender and compassionate. Jeremiah is called the weeping prophet because he wept over the political situation in his day. We need more men who are weeping over the political situation of our day. Jesus wept over Jerusalem (Luke 19:41) and the future He saw for that city. Jesus wept at Lazarus' tomb (John 11:35). We need men with hearts of compassion.

We need men who are open minded.

One of the saddest sights to behold is a man who thinks he knows everything and has no need to learn anything. A man who can say "I was wrong" is a man willing to learn and grow in his marriage and with his children.

We need men who love their families.

God wants men who are willing to be responsible in leadership in their homes, loyal to their wife and children. A provider of their physical needs and their spiritual needs.

Men must have faith which involves total commitment to God. Read Psalm 1:1-6.
