For we are God's fellow workers; 1st Corinthians 3:9 NKJV

Sometimes, sincere believers act as if the Christian ministry is a work that God has given them to do *for* Him, but that is not the teaching of the New Testament. Rather than calling us to do something *for* Him, God calls us to join *with* Him in His purpose which He is pursuing.

And what is God's purpose?

The Apostle Paul defined that purpose in 2nd Corinthians 5:18-21.

Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,

that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.

For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Note: God who "reconciled us" has "given us the ministry" and "committed to us the word of reconciliation." And how is that ministry performed? It is "as though God were pleading through us."

We are not simply working *for* God. God is working *with* us! Is it not an awesome thought that you can work with God, that He will include you in His great plan to reconcile sinners to Himself?

Most jobs have some kind of retirement benefit. The employer and/or employee contribute to a retirement fund from which the employee, upon retirement, draws a monthly income until he dies. Obviously, that is a good thing but it is also a temporal thing – it will not last forever.

There is however another work that has a far greater benefit in this life and in the one to come. It is the eternal, unchanging work of God. It is the work God decided to do before He ever began the magnificent work of creation.

It is the work of salvation – rescuing, redeeming, and restoring wayward sinners.

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, did His work of atonement, offering Himself as the sacrifice that would take away sin and save sinners. Of His work, our blessed Lord declared on the cross, "*It is finished.*"

God the Holy Spirit is doing His work of "*convincing the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment.*"

And what role is given to the church?

We are to proclaim the gospel.

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

Matthew 28:18-20

We are to send the gospel.

As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them. And when they had fasted and prayed, and laid their hands on them, they sent them away. So they, being sent forth by the Holy Ghost, departed unto Seleucia; and from thence they sailed to Cyprus.

Acts 13:2-4

Note that Paul and Silas were sent by the church and by the Holy Spirit. Indeed, "*we are God's fellow workers.*"








Word of Life "Dot-tober" October Incentive





As we close out the first month of our new 2018-2019 club year, we wanted to keep up our momentum and excitement by offering an incentive to our clubbers for October. We want to encourage the clubbers to continue to pursue success in their weekly accountability by letting them "dot" one of the leaders with stickers. Every sticker represents each accountability activity they complete during the month of October. How does this work? The Word of Life program centers around these four accountability activities: daily quiet time/prayer, scripture memory, Christian service, and furthering their Christian walk reading a book from the approved reading list. So, clubbers can earn ONE DOT for each of the following:

- ⇒ One week (ALL 7 days) of completed daily Quiet Times
 - ⇒ A NEW verse recited from memory from their verse list (does not include verses they've already said)
 - ⇒ A Christian service performed and submitted with an adult's signature
 - ⇒ Read an approved book (for the first time) from the WOL library




