Paul had an objective – to reach “every man” with the truths of Christ.

Yes, he also had an interest in reaching women for Christ. Consider him and Silas ministering to Lydia and her family plus the jailer and his family in Acts 16.

However, given today’s challenge in reaching men, Paul’s statement in Colossians 1:28 is of particular interest.

R. Kent Hughes in his book, *Disciplines of a Godly Man*, states, “*men are so much less spiritually inclined and spiritually disciplined than women*” and “*the fact remains that men today need far more help in building spiritual discipline than women.*”

Thinking back through the years, it is evident that Brother Hughes is on target. In our experiences here at TLBC, more often than not, the ladies have had more interest in spiritual matters. Rare have been the times of seeing saved husbands and lost wives but it has not been uncommon to see saved wives with lost husbands.

Across the board, the pressing need is to reach more men and to equip more men. In our communities, families often suffer from the absence or silence of men.

There is a great potential where men are reached and grounded in Biblical truths. The marriage, the children, the family as a unit, the workplace, the community, and the church can be affected for good.

“O God, give us more men who love you with all their hearts, their wives, their children, and their fellowman even as they love themselves. Amen.”

This year marks the 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Men’s Wild Game Banquet here at TLBC. Since day one, our aim has remained the same: to use men’s interest in hunting, fishing, etc. as a platform for introducing them to Christ. We have a guest speaker with some connection to outdoor activities who will include a gospel presentation.

Please pray for this year’s event on February 23. Most likely, there will be men present who are not saved and men whose spiritual disciplines are lacking.

The need is real. The need is great.
