Year after year, even from generation to generation, boys and girls have come to a weeklong Vacation Bible School. (At one time VBS was two weeks!) Daily they have stood and repeated the words of this pledge along with the pledges to the American flag and the Christian flag.

Do the youngsters appreciate what they are reading from a video projection or perhaps quoting from memory? Probably just about as much as adults do on the rare occasion when they also recite the words.

But be that as it may, the reason we have VBS is that simple – to encourage and hopefully to influence young lives to commit their allegiance to God's Word.

Can there be a nobler effort than that?

Since faith comes by hearing God's Word, a systematic exposure to the teachings and promises of God's Word is a commendable labor.

How we ought to support and to appreciate those who give themselves to daily teach and prayerfully reach young souls for Christ!

And what is the potential for VBS?

Imagine a boy or girl, stirred by grace, who is convinced to believe and to obey God's Word. Perhaps they would borrow the words of the psalmist who said, *"Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path."* Psalms 119:105  
And the same child is concerned about his own words and thoughts so he commits to memory Psalm 19:14, *"Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O LORD, my strength and my Redeemer."*

But of course, the chief aim of studying and learning the Bible is to know Jesus, the subject of the Scriptures.

*"But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name."* John 20:31

That young life with a simple faith in Jesus can grow and develop into a mature faith with a resolute confidence in God.

The words of Acts 27:25 might one day be his own. *"Therefore take heart, men, for I believe God that it will be just as it was told me."* Or the day may come when as a young man he faces a test and he answers as did Peter in Acts 5:29, *"But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: "We ought to obey God rather than men."*

The boys and girls you see in Vacation Bible School this year will soon be men and women, husbands and wives, dads and moms. What they experience now could have a profound effect of what they will be then.

Let us pray and seek our God's favor upon this noble effort.

*"O God, give us these precious souls. Save them for your glory and that they might know the life that comes only through your Son who died for our sins and was raised for our justification. Open their eyes to the truth of your Word. Deliver them from an aimless, empty, wasted life and bless them instead with life that is more abundant.*

*Bless your dear servants who will labor to bring the Word to these young minds. Give them the wisdom that they might do well and the stamina needed to finish well. For the furtherance of your kingdom, we pray. Amen"*

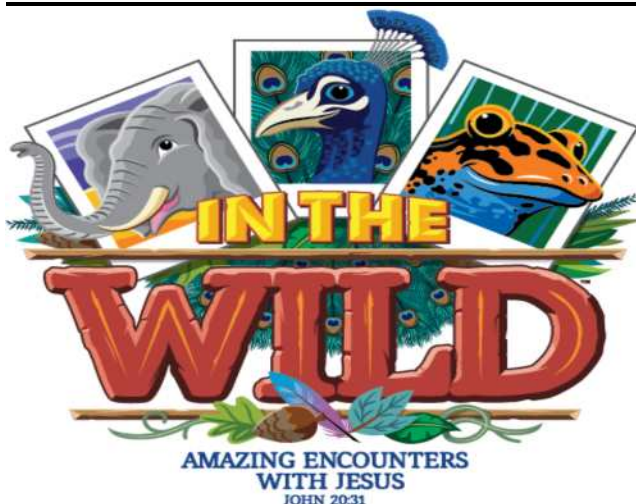
## VBS Is a Field to Be Harvested

# LIVING AS A DISCIPLE OF JESUS

## “BELIEVE” in Jesus

What does it mean to believe? And what does it mean to believe in Jesus? To believe means to have faith; and we are to have faith/belief in Jesus.

But as a friend of mine said recently, many people in the local church have the “belief” of demons. That is, people have a belief in Jesus that He existed; that He came and died on the cross; that He has power to raise the dead, cast out demons and they can even confess He is the Son of God. Like demons, they believe *truths about Jesus*, but it makes no difference in how they live.

A demon confessed that Jesus is the holy one of God in Mark 1:24 “...What business do we have with each other, Jesus of Nazareth? Have You come to destroy us? I know who You are—the Holy One of God!” James 2:19 states “You believe that God is one. You do well; the demons also believe, and shudder.” There it is, the belief of demons that acknowledges the right things about Jesus and God, but is a *belief that does not lead to repentance and loyalty to Him*.

Jesus described those with empty belief in Matthew 7:21-23 when He declared, “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven... Many will say to Me on that day, ‘Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?’ And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.’”

To BELIEVE means to have faith in Jesus, that is to give your allegiance and loyalty to Jesus as God in the flesh who is Lord over all. And that BELIEF *leads to obedience and worship*. To BELIEVE in Jesus means life is no longer about us, but about Him; it is about what He says, not what we want; it is to *trust in Him*, not ourselves, nor in another, nor in the government... *trust in Jesus*... for our protection, provision, and eternal life. BELIEF in Jesus is to take our problems, anxieties, depression, despair, guilt, shame, and concerns to Him in prayer; and to read His word to learn how to worship Him and live in the midst of our emotions, circumstances, and concern for others.

Jesus defined what BELIEF in Him looks like, and it has nothing to do with praying a prayer, raising a hand, walking an aisle, getting baptized, joining a church, etc. This is what Jesus stated in Mark 8:34-38 - “...If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the gospel’s will save it. For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world, and forfeit his soul? For what will a man give in exchange for his soul? For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will also be ashamed of him when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels.”

*Do we BELIEVE in Jesus?* It might be better to ask, do we daily deny ourselves to do what Jesus says? Are we daily dying to ourselves to live for Jesus? Are we daily following Jesus? Are we setting aside our wants for Jesus and the gospel?

To merely say we “believe” in Jesus is easy; but to truly BELIEVE in Jesus, is life changing, the path to peace, and where hope resides.

Unlike the demons, let us BELIEVE in Him!

A small stipend will be given to the child care workers and a background check is required.

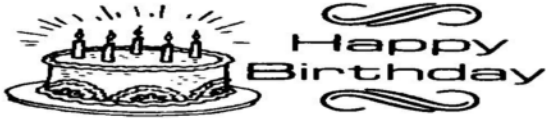
