

"Four Scriptural Principles for Giving" Sunday morning series in March

Principle #1 "Ownership: the Critical Question"

We will begin the series by asking ourselves "Whose is it anyways?"

According to Psalm 24:1 (NKJV) "The earth is the LORD's, and all its fullness, The world and those who dwell therein." Applying this one Biblical truth that God is the sole owner of everything will cause us to alter our perspective on life, adjust our priority for life, and apply the right practice in life.

Principle #2 "Stewardship: the Biblical Response"

According to the Bible, God (Owner) has entrusted us with our time, our talents and our treasures. That makes us stewards (trustees) of all that we have. Biblical stewardship extends beyond the portion we give in the offering on Sundays. It also includes the greater portion we keep for paying our bills, saving, and all other uses. Stewardship is more than writing a check or having an automatic withdrawal; stewardship is how we live our lives 24/7. Our lives are bent either towards ourselves doing what we want or towards God seeking to do His will.

Principle #3 "Relationship: the Personal Factor"

We give not to appease some greedy ogre but to express our faith in Him who is our Heavenly Father. He knows our human tendency is to selfishly claim and cling to our toys while yelling like a little tot, "Mine!"

Giving our tithes and offerings is a discipline that demonstrates the priority of our Father in our lives. As Jesus taught us in Matthew 6, instead of worrying about things such as food and clothing we are to, "seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you." Matthew 6:33 (NKJV)

He added a personal touch by reminding them and us: "For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things." Matthew 6:32 (NKJV)

Principle #4 "Worship: the Principal Motive"

Solomon wrote that we should "Honor the LORD with [our] possessions, And with the first-fruits of all [our] increase;" Proverbs 3:9 (NKJV)

Our objective in living and in giving is one and the same: to honor God. Remember how the Apostle Paul told the Corinthians, "God loves a cheerful giver." (2nd Corinthians 9:7 NKJV) God is pleased when we are pleased to give to Him, to His work, to the spread of His word, and to the furtherance of His kingdom.

I pray we will see that how we live, how we serve and how we give are all involved in this matter of God's ownership and our stewardship. I further pray that we will enjoy the freedom of seeing this all as opportunities to express our love and faith to our Father with the single, sincere desire to honor Him.

I invite you to join with me in this journey.
