In Adam we Die... In Christ we Live

For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

1st Corinthians 15:22

Some Biblical truths are blunt and straightforward. Here is one of them. In Adam we die. In Christ we live. Adam, the federal head of the human race, made a critical and fatal choice (and so did Eve) to disobey God's clear instructions and not heed His serious warning. *"But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."* Genesis 2:17 NKJV

But that is just what they did.

The scene described in Genesis 3 of God coming down to confront them, to curse them and to cast them out of Eden is graphic. God's holy character had been offended and His commandment violated. He would not wink at their rebellious sin. On that dramatic day in Genesis 3, Adam and Eve died – not physically but spiritually. Eventually, they would each die physically and that too would be the consequence of their sinful actions.

And there would be more consequences.

In a tragic irony, before facing their own physical deaths, they first witnessed the physical death of their son, Abel at the hand of their older son, Cain.

How painful it must have been to realize that in part they contributed to the death of their son.

"Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned—"

"Romans 5:12 NKJV

Spiritual death is separation from God. This was depicted by the actions of God driving the couple from the Garden and posting Cherubim and a flaming sword.

Adam and Eve were alienated from God as were their children and all who descend after them - including you and me.

Adam's legacy is a death far worse than any bubonic plague ever to strike the human race for there are no exceptions. *"In Adam ALL die."*

What a sad and distressful reality. The human race is afflicted by the fatal effect of sin that, if left to itself, eternally dooms the soul to hell and from the presence of God. And that same spiritual malady is the root cause for all the social ills in our communities and around the world.

Thankfully, the Scripture also declares that *"in Christ shall all be made alive."*

How are we related to Adam? By our first birth which was physical. Psalm 51:5

How are we related to Christ? By our second birth which is spiritual. John 3:1-8

Have you been born again? That is what it means to be saved from the curse of Adam's race. It is an act of the Holy Spirit birthing you into God's family.

Have you confessed (agreed) to your sinfulness. *"God be merciful to me a sinner."* Luke 18:13

Do you confess today the exclusivity and sufficiency of Christ who by His crucifixion and resurrection is able to save all who come to Him in faith and repentance?

During this month as we give special attention to the powerful victory achieved by Christ's endurance of the cross and defeat of the grave, let us shout out the timeless truth, *In Christ we live forever and forever!*

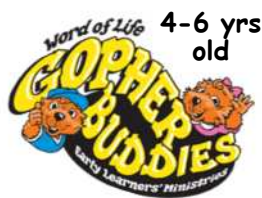
