Walk in good works. Ephesians 2:10

Walk in truth. 3 John 3-4

The works of the flesh are disruptive and bring pain. The works of the Spirit bring peace and bring healing.

4. Rejoice in the conquest you have through the Spirit. (vv.24-25)

a. The flesh has been crucified with Christ.

Galatians 2:20 and Romans 6:1-7

Do <u>you want to walk by the Spirit?</u> Daily deny yourself, pick up your cross and follow Jesus! Stay in the Word of God!

b. The life we live now is to be in step with the Spirit. (v.25)

To live by the Spirit is to live a sanctified life as a child of God.

To walk by the Spirit is to surrender you will/desires to the Spirit moment by moment.

Walk by the Spirit could be translated to "keep in step". To keep in step is to be in line with a person or thing considered as standard for one's conduct.
