a. There's the lesson of **creation**.

Genesis 1:26-27; Acts 17:24-26

(1) We are all here by an act of our Creator God.

(2) We are all descendants of Adam.

(3) Though marred by sin, we are all created in the image of God.

b. There's the lesson of the Great **Commandment**.

James 2:8-9; Ephesians 5:1-2

c. There's the lesson of the Great **Commission**.

Matthew 28:18-20

d. There's the lesson of **common** sense.

2. The **Lordship** of Christ conquers the spirit of racism.

a. There is the **extent** of Christ's reign. *"He is Lord of all"*

b. There is the **effect** of Christ's reign. *"preaching peace"*

3. The **Language** of the Gospel counteracts any sentiments of racism.

a. Deliverance from sin is one and the same: by **grace** through **faith**.

b. Distinctions that once separated us are now negated.

c. Destiny of all the saved is one and the same: **Heaven**.
