Judgment in the Bible involves...

- God's righteous activity: God's actions are never impulsive and explosive but always appropriate and right.
- God's judicial integrity: There is never a wrongful act of injustice with God.
- Our personal responsibility: No one can excuse himself/herself by blaming others or happenings.
- Our personal accountability: Each person must answer for himself/herself.
