

Guidelines in Selecting and Awarding The French Broad Baptist Association Scholarship Endowment

A copy of these guidelines shall be attached to the endowment agreement existing between the French Broad Baptist Association and the North Carolina Baptist Foundation, Inc., and a copy shall be provided to each prospective applicant.

I. APPLICANTS

1. May be either male or female.
2. Must be of the Protestant faith or background.
3. Must be a member of the French Broad Baptist Association at the time of this application which, for the purposes of these guidelines, is generally described as Madison County, North Carolina and contiguous counties.
4. Must be seeking training beyond the high school level.
5. Application must be filed with the French Broad Baptist Association Scholarship Committee no later than March 30th, prior to the school year.
6. Applicant must be seeking a degree in Pastoral Ministry, Youth Ministry, Christian Music Ministry or Christian Education.

II. RECIPIENT

1. Shall submit evidence to the French Broad Baptist Association to prove his/her need for financial assistance.
2. Shall have met entrance requirement and be accepted by a post secondary institution (College, Institution, University, or Technical/Community College.)
3. Exhibits high moral character, dedication to family, church, and community.

III. GRANTS

1. Shall be awarded on a one-year basis, subject to review and re-submission of application before being continued in subsequent year.
2. May be awarded to one or more eligible recipients, at the discretion of the committee, and in amounts determined solely by the committee.
3. Will be paid to school of choice and not to recipient, but may be delivered to recipient for him/her to deposit with school.
4. Recipients(s) shall be recommended to the French Broad Baptist Association in its May Executive Meeting by the French Broad Baptist

Associational Scholarship Endowment Committee.

- 5 Selected recipients(s) will be announced after the May Executive Meeting.
- 6 The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to make no grant in any one year should there be no applicant who, in the opinion of the committee qualifies according to all requirements of these guidelines. In such event, the committee will advise the North Carolina Baptist Foundation, and may:
 - i. Elect to waive the geographical requirement as set forth in item I. (3) of these guidelines, and will confer with the North Carolina Baptist Foundation in a mutual effort to award the scholarship(s) to other worthy candidates who present themselves to the North Carolina Baptist Foundation with the intent of attending one of the Baptist-sponsored colleges, institutions, or technical/community colleges sponsored by the Southern Baptist Convention and who meet all other requirements of these guidelines, or
 - ii. direct that the amount available for awards in any one year be added to the endowment corpus.
- 7 In the event that The French Broad Baptist Association ceases to exist, the Board of Directors of the North Carolina Baptist Foundation, Inc., in its sole discretion, shall select and designate worthy beneficiaries who are attending, or have been accepted by one of the Baptist colleges, institutions, universities, technical/community colleges or Southern Baptist theological seminaries supported by the Southern Baptist Convention, so that funds can continue to carry out, as nearly as possible, the purposes of the French Broad Baptist Association.
