By my child's participation in any such activity or event I acknowledge that the participant has my permission to participate and I agree that this Release shall be valid and binding as to all such activities/events participated in, unless I give written revocation of such release. Furthermore, I (and on behalf of my child if applicable), hereby assume all risk or personal injury, sickness, death, damage and expense as a result of participation in recreation, work activities or other activities involved with any such activity/event, further, authorization and permission to furnish any necessary transportation, food and lodging for the participant.

Bible Camp will be July 21-26, 2019 at The Oaks Retreat in Greeneville, TN. The price per Camper is \$170.00 and all registration forms must be turned in no later than July 11, 2019. T-shirts cannot be ordered after July 11, 2019. For insurance purposes, EVERYONE must be registered prior to departure. All Campers must be at Broyhill Chapel on the campus of Mars Hill University by 2:30 PM on July 21, 2019. Please pick up your child(ren) at the Baptist Center when we return around 12:00 PM on July 26th.

Campers' registration forms must be signed by a parent or guardian. Campers without properly completed forms will not be permitted to attend. Campers can be registered at the Baptist Center from 8:30 am – 5:00pm on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Many churches collect their members' forms and payments and bring them to the Baptist Center all together.

Bus transportation will be provided from Broyhill Chapel to Camp on Sunday and from Camp to the Baptist Center on Friday. Due to insurance restrictions, all Campers must ride the buses unless they have written permission from their parent/guardian. Campers are not allowed to drive their own vehicles to/from Camp.

MEDICAL PROBLEMS/MEDICATIONS: Campers who have medical problems (allergies, illness, etc.) or are taking medications must notify the Camp Nurse. The Camp Nurse will have a station at Broyhill Chapel to receive medications and medical information on the day of our departure. A written explanation of medicines (type, dosage, when to be given, etc.) must be included on the Registration form. All medicines are to be given only by the Camp Nurse so all medications can be properly administered and documented. **We reserve the right to ask for parent or guardian support at camp for any camper who may have serious medical or emotional needs.**

CAMPERS SHOULD BRING:

- Bible, notepad, pen
- 4-5 pairs of casual clothing for church service and 4-5 pairs of recreational clothing for activities
- A lightweight raincoat or poncho
- Pillow and sleeping bag or sheets & blanket
- Flashlight and toilet articles such as towels, washcloths, soap, shampoo. Toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.

THE CAMPERS NAME should be on all towels, underwear, shirts, pants, etc. so that they can be properly claimed and returned. Lost & found items will be held for up to 2 weeks and unclaimed articles will then be donated to a local charity. Call the Baptist Center at 689-2845 Tuesday – Thursday to reclaim lost articles.

DRESS CODE FROM FRENCH BROAD BAPTIST ASSOCIATION BIBLE CAMP HANDBOOK

In fitting with the intent of Bible Camp both staff and campers shall exhibit modesty in their dress.

The following guidelines are to be followed:

- Skirts/Dresses for staff/campers shall be no more than 1" above the knee.
- No "short-shorts" for campers/staff. Shorts are to be 1" below fingerprints.
- No strapless, halter tops, or spaghetti straps for tops on female staff/campers.
- No muscle shirts or altered T-shirts for male staff/campers.
- Girls: Non-white tee shirts and shorts shall be worn over swimsuit.
- Boys: Non-white tee shirts and shorts or long swim trunks shall be worn.

We have a limited amount of medical insurance coverage for accidents incurred while at Camp.

Visitors on Wednesday Evening

Church Service will begin with singing at 7:00 and the Worship Service will follow at 7:30. For visitors desiring to eat supper at Camp, we ask that you provide an \$8.00 fee for your meal. There will be a staff member present in the cafeteria who can receive the fee. Cabin groups begin eating at 5:45.

VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION – PLEASE READ

We appreciate that you have considered our Bible Camp. This Camp has been a positive influence for our youth for 40+ years. A number of youth have come to know Jesus, rededicate their lives, and answer the call to Christian ministry during the week. Bible Camp has God’s blessings on it as we have been able to reach youth throughout the area.

We carefully select the staff and counselors who serve at camp. They are members in good standing with our local churches and are recommended by their pastors. Due diligence is paid by having background checks performed for all our staff. Counselors and staff are volunteers and are not paid employees of the French Broad Baptist Association. They are required to complete an application process which includes a fee. Counselors and staff attend training to work with our youth for the week. The term “counselor” is used for the staff who supervise the cabin groups and reside in the cabins with the Campers. Please note that our counselors are not counselors by profession but are volunteers who serve in a parental-type role during camp. **We reserve the right to ask for parent or guardian support at camp for any camper who may have serious medical or emotional needs.**

Camp fees are non-refundable after the deadline for camp registration (July 11, 2019). If staff/campers camp fee is being paid by a church, the registration forms are to be processed through the church who will then deliver the fees to the Baptist Center. The church must confirm they will be paying for the staff/campers.

CAMPERS SHOULD NOT BRING electronic devices, food, or clothing not suitable for a Christian Camp.

Campers are not allowed to have cell phones or other electronic devices at Camp. **If Campers are seen with cell phones or electronic devices, the device(s) will be collected by the counselor and will be returned on Friday.** If campers need to call out, they are to go through their counselors or another member of the staff and this should be approved by the Camp Director or Assistant Camp Director as to the situation. In case of an emergency, the staff will contact the parents/guardians. Parents/Guardians are welcome to contact the staff during the week to check on their Camper. For safety/security purposes, if Campers are picked up during the week, it is required they be picked up at the Nurse’s Station at The Oaks Lodge Building in order for the staff to know they have been taken from camp. Only those designated on the registration as authorized to pick up will be allowed to take the Camper off site.

Campers are to refrain from any and all public displays of affection which includes the following – hugging, kissing, holding hands, and or any other physical contact with another Camper with an affectionate intent.
