

**God's Righteous Choices, Romans 9-11**  
Whosoever Will Be Saved: Romans 10:5-15

- I. Righteousness comes from faith in Jesus (10:5-8).  
Man is not made righteous through the law but through faith in Jesus.
- II. Faith in Jesus brings salvation from sin (10:9-13).
  - A. Faith in Jesus brings a response to the believer (10:9).
    - 1. There is confession that Jesus is Lord (10:9a).
    - 2. There is trust in the gospel of Jesus (10:9b).
  - B. Confession and trust are a definitive response to faith in Jesus (10:10).
  - C. Faith in Jesus results in salvation to everyone (10:11-13).
- III. There is a pathway to faith in Jesus (10:14-15).
  - A. Paul outlines a pathway to faith by using a series of questions.
    - 1. Question 1: How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed?
    - 2. Question 2: How will they believe in Him if they have not heard?
    - 3. Question 3: How will they hear without a preacher?
    - 4. Question 4: How will they preach unless they are sent?
  - B. A person is blessed to share the Good News of salvation (10:15b).
