Any person who is not yet part of God's Kingdom should be afraid.
Spiritual realm ←→ Physical realm

*Where do you need to take up the shield of faith?
IV. In the Spiritual war, remember God's rules over all (vss. 22-27). Notice where Joshua places this "cursed" people (vss. 23 & 27) Consider the Gibeonites (a picture of salvation):

*Might there be a fear God is using in your life?
