Presence is a powerful thing. An encouraging presence even more so!

**I. A faithful person encourages others by \_\_\_\_\_ God's \_\_\_\_\_ in their presence (vs. 6).**

Testimonies are powerful!

*"You know what the Lord said..."*

\*What truth from Gods Word do you need to be reminded of today?

*"Moses the man of God..."*

**II. A faithful person encourages others by \_\_\_\_\_ truth even when it's not the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ view (vss. 7-9).**

*"We are not able..."* (Numbers 13:31)

*"...which I am giving to the people of Israel"* (Number 13:2).

\*Which of these two groups do you most resemble?

\*If love *"bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things"* (1 Cor. 13:7), do you truly bring love for others to the table?

Caleb *"wholly followed the Lord."*

**III. A faithful person encourages others by \_\_\_\_\_ the Lord in \_\_\_\_\_ times (vss. 10-15).**

Actions can negate our encouraging words.

*"Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths"* (Proverbs 3:5-6).

Kept alive for a purpose!

Faithful people will have to deal with sins and failures of others. But those sins and failures do not hinder their faithfulness. Rather, they provide a backdrop whereby their faithfulness shines brighter. (Lord, may this be true of us!)

Caleb's great trust in vs. 12:

- His request...

- His acceptance of the outcome as God sees fit...

*"These are died in faith, not having received the things promised, but having seen them and greeted them from afar..."* (Hebrews 11:13).
