Chorus: Hallelujah Hallelujah Praise the One risen Son of God!

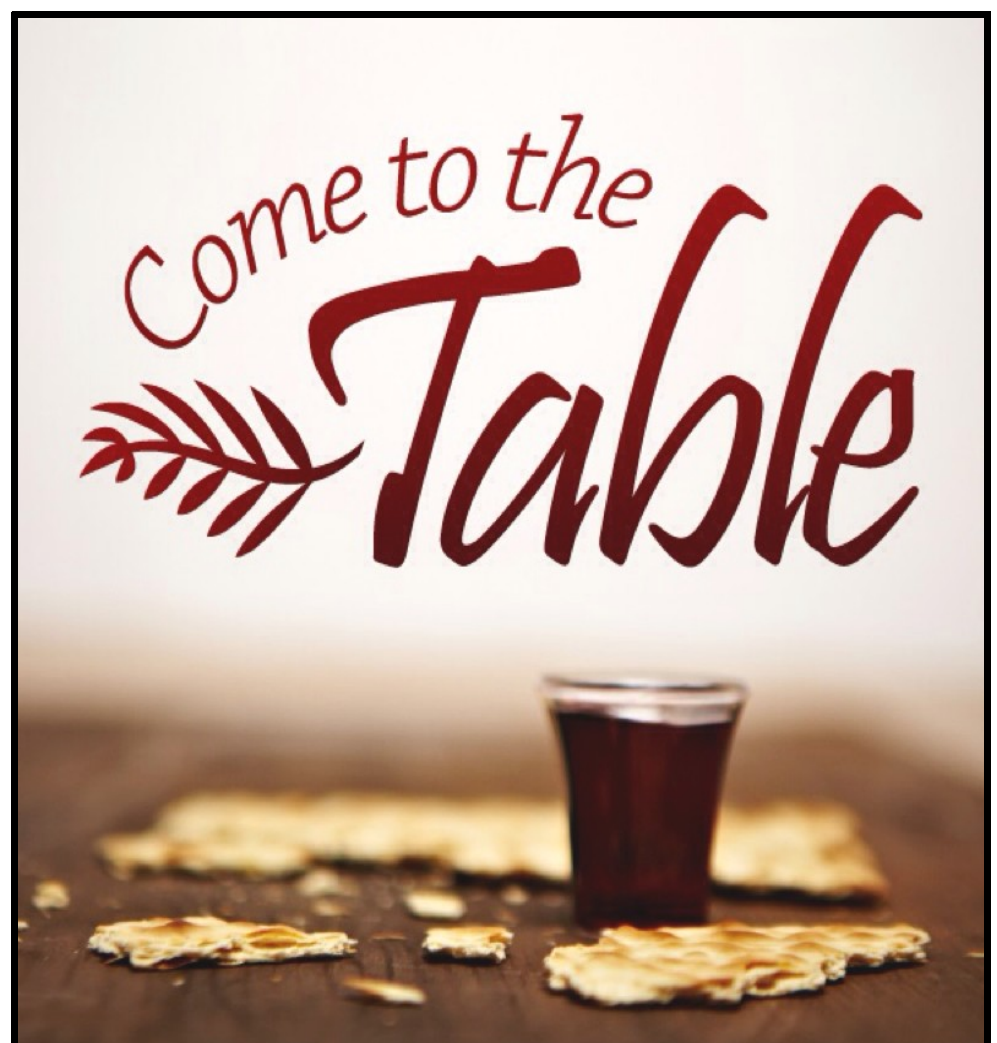
