

-From the Pastor's Desk-

"Then Moses said to God, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here." - Exodus 33:15

There are three lessons I find in Exodus chapter 33 and for the New Year that is upon us. **First**, there is a journey to be made. I do not want to say to myself 12 months from now; "Where did the time go?" I want to see where I have gone. To be able to measure the progress that I have made. In verse one God tells Moses: "Depart and go up from here". The first lesson to be learned is that there is somewhere God wants us to be. And it is not only onward but upward! As the hymn writer puts it: "I'm pressing on the upward way, new heights I'm gaining every day". It does not matter from where You begin 2024 but it will matter where You end it. The Lord goes on to say: "To the Land I have given You".

We not only need divine progress in 2024 but **secondly** we need divine promise to get where God wants us to be. God has in essence given us the same promise He originally gave to Abraham. It may not be land....but it is a life. A life flowing with "milk and honey". So let 2024 begin with the promise of God. God promised to send His Angel before them to drive out the existing People living in the land. In the same manner God promises to go before You this next Year to not only face the challenges we will encounter but to fight with us. He does this in two ways. First, God knows what we will face and will prepare us if we allow Him and then will give us the power necessary to defeat them. He does this so we can continue our upward journey in the New Year.

Not only should we find progress this next year; not only can we depend on what God has promised us to complete out journey into the life He describes for us; but the **third** lesson is that we must have the presence of God to go with us. God told the People that His presence would not go with them. This caused the People to mourn over their past behavior. As we look back over 2023 and what could have been, we too should mourn. But just as Moses found grace in the eyes of the Lord so we also can find this same grace to leave 2023 behind and move forward and upward in 2024. How will we know we are on the right path in 2024? It will be the Glory of the Lord that will determine that.

Please read the entire chapter of Exodus 33. There is so much more as we face the challenges of the New Year. It is the grace of God that will lead us into the glory of God. Progress is the Promise of God as we walk in His Presence. God's very best as we move forward together.
