

-From the Pastor's Desk-

"And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn." - Luke 2:7

"Leave Room for God"

Is there room for God in Your Life? Christmas is now in our rearview mirror. The first month of the New Year gone. But the question still lingers...have You made room for God? I often wonder about those who missed the coming of the Son of God the first time. King Herod missed out. The Religious Experts advising Herod where the King of the Jews was to be born missed out. And of course the anonymous Inn Keeper who had no room for the Savior of the World missed out as well. And so the question stands for this New Year. Have You made room for God?

In the Parable of the Sower there were four types of soil pictured. The first was the hard ground. The seed sown found no place and was soon "snatched" away. Opportunity lost. The second type of soil was the rocky, shallow ground. The seed showed promise as it quickly sprouted because there was nowhere for it to go but up. When the sun inevitably came out the tender shoot quickly withered because there was no root to sustain it. The third type of soil was the ground that was never weeded. The seed did its part but in competition with the more aggressive thorns & thistles, soon was "choked" out. The last type of soil Jesus labeled "fertile". It produced a harvest many times what was originally sown. This last soil made room for God. It was prepared for His appearing.

As servants of God we need to make a place where the seed of His word can be received and nurtured to full term providing a harvest worthy of God's investment. We make our plans for the upcoming Year, but forget to make room for God. In Proverbs we read; "In their hearts humans plan their course, but the LORD establishes their steps." (16:9) What Solomon learned is "Yes!" make Your plans. But make room for God to guide Your steps. How many times have we missed the best of God because we made no room for Him. Do not look for God to come in a particular manner, *look for Him!* The best way to make room for God in Your life is to: expect Him to come; to look for Him to participate; and to be prepared to receive His leading and to sow right along with You. Our responsibility is to prepare our hearts to be looking for God by softening the soil; removing the rocks, thorns and thistles that hinder His work if not choke it out altogether. How wonderful it is to be "surprised" by God showing up and sowing into our Life.

Live in a constant state of expectancy and be sure to leave room for God. Do not be like those who missed His first coming. Because He is coming.
