

-From the Pastor's Desk-

"You too, be patient and stand firm, because the Lord's coming is near." - James 5:8

Resurrection Sunday is behind us and Revelation Day is somewhere in our future. This coming Sunday we will be having two messages on the Lord's return. Seventeen books in the Old Testament mention the second coming of Jesus to set up His millennial kingdom. 23 of our 27 books speak about some aspect of His return. So in all about 70% of the chapters make some reference to the Return of our Savior. In light of this how much time do we spend reflecting, let alone sharing about His return?

The Epistle of James has three reminders about the Lord's return. First, is to be patient. Jesus in the Gospel of Luke muses whether there will even be any faith left upon the earth when He returns (18:8). The word James uses here is one of tension - like the current of a river. The "pull" of heaven should be so great that we often get discouraged living in the world today. We are far too comfortable and successful in this world. We read in Peter of Lot living in Sodom and that his soul was "vexed" by what was taking place around him. When was the last time your soul was "vexed" by something on the TV, movies, or internet? When Jesus hung upon the cross the Father had to "look away" when our sin was placed upon Him. When was the last time we "looked away" in horror over what is taking place around us? James says "be patient" yet there is no sense of longing for the Lord's return among His People today. We are His bride and our heart should long to be with Him.

In John chapter fourteen Jesus tells His disciples that He goes to prepare a place for us; "that where He is we might be also". Is that the desire of our heart? Is our soul "vexed" as we wait for His return? We should live in the same constant tension as our Lord and Savior. Jesus desired to return to His home and to His Father. We should have that same "pull" to be with those whom we love most. James speaks of this patience: to stay focused on His work while we wait.

James also reminds us to stand firm. To "put on" the armor of God listed in Ephesians chapter six. Why should we be patient when our hearts long to be with those we love most? How can we stand firm against this "pull" of heaven? James reminds us that the return of the Lord is imminent! It is soon! Next. For all of You who live with a "vexed" soul and "long" for the return of our Savior remember these words from James: Be patient in Your pain; stand firm in Your work while waiting for the Lord's return; and remember that it is imminent. Jesus gave His disciples some encouraging words in Luke's gospel; "When these things begin to take place, stand up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near." - Pastor Ted -
