

Magnet Letters

- Gather magnet letters – the ones below were purchased through Oriental Trading. If you don't have a metal filing cabinet, bring in a cookie sheet. Below, a magnet/dry erase board purchased at Ocean State was used.
- Help children learn books of the Bible, by posting or writing a book of the Bible and having them find the letters to spell that book. Encourage children to say the book and spell it out loud as they work.



Ideas:

- This is a great activity for young children learning just a few books at a time.
- Use this activity for older children learning the divisions of the Old or New Testament.
- Have children use letters to spell out the names of the books of the Bible before or after the book written.
