



Track Your Journey in Matthew




2018 Book of Matthew Reading Plan

Dear Parents,

Our Kids Matter Kid's Ministry team hope that you are enjoying using our resources with your child in reading through the book of Matthew during 2018. In the pages ahead, you will find your reading plan for April, May and June. As in our previous resource, we are encouraging your child to read the verses suggested each week and complete the very short assignment after each reading. We hope that you are encouraging them to journal their responses and activities. Journaling is a great habit for your child to get into!

On the back of this reading plan your child can track their progress by coloring in the shapes for the corresponding verses they read each week.



March 26, 2018—June 17, 2018

#1 March 26—April 1, 2018 — Read Matthew 7:18-29

This week you will be learning to build your life on the solid rock of Jesus (Matthew 7:24). In your journal, write some ways that you can stay rooted in Christ when the storms come.

#2 April 2—April 8, 2018 — Read Matthew 8:1-17

Jesus is greater than any sickness. Pray for individuals that you know need a healing touch from Jesus. Send them a card and tell them that you are praying for them.

#3 April 9—April 15, 2018 — Read Matthew 8:18-34

What does it mean to follow Jesus? Is it easy to follow Jesus? How can I be a better follower? Talk to a friend about what it means to follow Jesus. Pray for yourself and your friend that you will be a better follower of Jesus.

#4 April 16—April 22, 2018 — Read Matthew 9:1-19

Jesus shows mercy in v. 9-13. What is mercy and how can that be shown in your life? Watch for an opportunity to show someone mercy today. Write about it in your journal.

#5 April 23—April 29, 2018 — Read Matthew 9:20-38

What is faith? Write your definition in your journal. Share your definition with a trusted grown up and ask them to pray for you to strengthen your faith.

#6 April 30—May 6, 2018 — Read Matthew 10:1-21

Jesus sent out leaders. What instructions did He give them? Write down a list of leaders and pray for them in light of the instructions that Jesus gave his followers.

#7 May 7—May 13, 2018 — Read Matthew 10:22-42

In vs. 40-42, Jesus instructs us to be welcoming. What does that mean? How can you be welcoming of others? Show welcome to someone today.

#8 May 14—May 20, 2018 — Read Matthew 11:1-15

John the Baptist was a helper to Jesus. How did John help Jesus? How can you be a helper to Jesus?

#9 May 21—May 27, 2018 — Read Matthew 11:16-30

Jesus wants us to be happy. He wants us to experience a life of true joy where nothing can weigh us down. What promise does Jesus make to us in Matthew 11:28-30?

#10 May 28—June 3, 2018 — Read Matthew 12:1-25

What is the Sabbath Day? In Matthew 12:1-14, Jesus had to show the people what God wanted them to do on the Sabbath Day. God made the Sabbath a day of rest and praising His name. How well do you do keeping the Sabbath as Jesus intended?

#11 June 4—June 10, 2018 — Read Matthew 12:26-50

In verses 33-37, we learn the impact of our words. What do these verses tell us? What do you need to do in light of these verses?

#12 June 11—June 17, 2018 — Read Matthew 13:1-17

Jesus taught the people in parables. What are parables and why did Jesus teach that way?
