What is the purpose of Outreach?

- The Great Commission through Evangelism.

Matthew 28:16-20 (KJV):

16 Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, into a mountain where Jesus had appointed them.

17 And when they saw him, they worshipped him: but some doubted.

18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, all power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

What is the purpose of Outreach? Cont'd

- To minister to the needs of the community (Spiritually & Naturally)

Mark 16:15

“He said to them, ‘Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.’”

Matthew 9:37-38 King James Version (KJV)

37 Then saith he unto his disciples, the harvest is plenteous, but the labourers are few.

38 Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.

To minister to the needs of the community (Spiritually)

Jesus Preaches and Feeds 5,000

- Matthew 14:13-21 King James Version (KJV)

When Jesus heard of it, he departed thence by ship into a desert place apart: and when the people had heard thereof, they followed him on foot out of the cities.

¹⁴ And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.

¹⁵ And when it was evening, his disciples came to him, saying, This is a desert place, and the time is now past; send the multitude away, that they may go into the villages, and buy themselves victuals.

¹⁶ But Jesus said unto them, They need not depart; give ye them to eat.

¹⁷ And they say unto him, We have here but five loaves, and two fishes.

¹⁸ He said, Bring them hither to me.

¹⁹ And he commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed, and brake, and gave the loaves to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.

²⁰ And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the fragments that remained twelve baskets full.

²¹ And they that had eaten were about five thousand men, beside women and children.

Outreach Evangelism Ministers to the Physical and Spiritual Needs of the Poor

- Food and Essential Daily Needs
- Job training and support
- Counseling
- Prayer, Healing, Deliverance
- Fellowship with the Community, allowing people to see Jesus through the congregation so that some who may never come to church may experience Jesus through out outreach.

Jesus Called His disciples his “witnesses”

- Acts 1:8

“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

- Jesus commanded them to share what they themselves have experienced, learned, and observed from Jesus via his teaching and his ministry.
- We are able to now share our own testimonies as witness of Jesus ourselves!

Note: To Witness: (giving the account of what we’ve experienced with Jesus, just as the disciples did.)

Evangelism- Sharing the Good News

- The good news is the “Plan of Redemption” the Gift of Eternal Life.
- Roman 10:14- How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?
- God’s desire is that all men would be saved! Romans 10:9-10.
- To Build the body of Christ through discipleship.
- Tim. 2:2, ““And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.’”

What is God's mission or intent in our calling?

- Luke 4:18,19 “The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.”
- 2 Tim. 2:4 The son of Man cometh, that not any man should perish, but that should come to repentance.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son (to the entire world!).

Definitions: Outreach, Evangelism

- Outreach Definition- The Act of Reaching Out.
- Evangelism Definition- Greek translation (To Proclaim the Good News)
- Outreach Functions- Community, Evangelism, Giving, Preaching, coming to aid those in need.

Principles Effective Outreach

- Keep your message aligned with the Gospel- the Good News!
- Use your personal experience with Jesus as a witness tool. You are witness of Jesus. God has commanded us to be his witnesses, just as he the disciples did in the early church Acts 1:8.
- Scriptures are an effective tool, but not required if you can't remember. You must however have a testimony. God uses your testimony.
- Utilize an outreach kit that builds a relationship (more details to come)

Principles of Effective Outreach Cont'd

- Acts of Love or Service in conjunction with sharing the gospel. See. Matthew 14:15-16
- Be fully aware of your authority in Jesus Christ to carry out the signs and wonders, new converts praying, healing, as your encounter souls!
- You must have a **passion** for building the Kingdom of God through the winning of souls, new converts, and seeing the works of Christ through his resurrected power be manifested etc. **(NO PASSION, NO PROGRESS)**

Evangelism Street Witnessing Tools

- Tool Kit- (Romans Road to Salvation Literature, contact cards, prayer request forms, Pen, evangelism tool ie., a sermon (optional).
- Utilize Street witnessing to build an audience and fellowship
- Know or understand your demographics of your community
- Brand Jesus by continuing to plant seeds in the same community
- Become a refuge for people to get Jesus, Healing, support, prayer. Etc. (PPBC becomes the shelter in their storm, and gives them a safe place to come and gain spiritual strength and healing.)

Spiritual Preparedness for Evangelism

- Be a born again Christian.
- Be willing to tell your testimony of faith and your personal walk.
- Understand the plan of salvation in your own life be willing to share this gift with others

- **Because of our sin, we are separated from God.**
- For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
- [\(Romans 3:23\)](#)
- **The Penalty for our sin is death.**
- For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Jesus Christ our Lord.
