

Wednesday Prayer Points June 17th

Holy Church Read Romans 12:1-5

Lord, the your church and make us more like Jesus, set apart for you. Mold us into a...

1. Sacrificial Church

"I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God..." (v. 1)

Following Christ is not a path of ease — He calls us to pick up our cross. Yet we do this in light of the mercy He has already shown us. So thank God and pray that we would set aside worldly comforts and live wholeheartedly for the Lord.

2. Countercultural Church

"Do not be conformed to this world..." (v. 2)

Our holy God calls us to live holy and distinct lives. Pray that we would truly love our community and show generosity towards others. Pray that we would unswerving show and commit to biblical priorities.

3. Transformed Church

"...but be transformed by the renewal of your mind..." (v. 2)

Believers are called to a lie of change. Think of 3-5 believers within our church and pray that God would mold them to be more like Jesus as they face joy and trials.

4. Humble Church

"For by the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think with sober judgment..." (v. 3)

Few characteristics are as ugly as pride. We are all sinners saved by grace and have no reason to look down on others. Take a moment to reflect on and repent of any pride in your heart. Pray that our church would have a compelling witness within the community as we seek to put others before ourselves.

5. Committed Church

"...so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another." (v. 5)

We should rejoice that our church is made up of different people with different spiritual gifts — all that God intends to use for His glory. Pray that every member would be passionate about using their gifts in ways that build up the church and honor Jesus Christ.
