- Attending leadership Meetings.
- Meeting with BSM staff once a week for triad check-ins.
- Be supportive of the ministry as a whole.
 - We realize that it is not always possible, but make **an effort** to attend Sam Houston BSM actives - including FOCUS, Beach Reach, Community Service Projects, and Abide.
 - *This is what constitutes as an “effort.” 1) Checking schedule to make sure you are free as soon as you first here about the event. 2) Marking the event in your calendar. 3) If appropriate, seek parental approval. 4) Saving up the money required to attend - sometimes this requires working an extra shift or doing an odd job here or there. 5) Signing up when sign-up sheets are offered.*
